











PM Peak Speed / Free Flow Speed




Remote Work Lessons


- Travel to work: 1/3 of VMT

UTA Ridership Trend: 2001-2020




Covid-19 Transit Impact: 2017-2021




UTA Annual Transit Passengers per Capita
