1. Approval of 01/11/16 Meeting Summary	Kim Clausing, Tooele County, made a motion to approve the January 11, 2016 meeting summary. Blaine Gehring, Tooele County, seconded the motion, and the committee voted unanimously.	Approved
2. Potential Modifications to Highway Element of Draft RPO Plan	<p>Wayne Bennion, WFRC, distributed copies of the draft RPO highway element from last summer and also copies of the highway improvements identified in the draft Tooele County Transportation Plan. The RPO discussed which of the County highway improvements should be incorporated into the RPO Plan, and some additional modifications to phasing. The following modifications to the RPO Plan were recommended:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Add an extension of Village Boulevard to Midvalley Highway in Phase 2.</li> <li>2) Extend Droubay Road into the Lakepoint area with connections to existing outlets in Phase 2.</li> <li>3) Add collector facilities north of I-80 with connection to SR-36 in Phase 2.</li> <li>4) Extend Bates Canyon Road to SR-138 in Phase 2.</li> <li>5) Shorten Tooele Parkway to not extend west of Sheep Lane.</li> <li>6) Add facility along north Depot fence between Mormon Trail Road and SR-112 in Phase 1.</li> <li>7) Shift southern section of Midvalley Highway to Phase 2.</li> <li>8) Shift SR-112 (SR-138 – Sheep Lane) to Phase 2.</li> <li>9) Shift SR-138 (Willow Street – Midvalley Highway) to Phase 2.</li> <li>10) Shift 2000 North (SR-112 – 400 West) to Phase 2.</li> <li>11) Change northern termini of SR-36 widening project to 550 South.</li> <li>12) Change northern termini of Tooele Boulevard new construction project to 700 South.</li> </ol> <p><b>Please contact Wayne Bennion at 801-363-4250 x1112 for more information.</b></p>	None Required
3. Potential Modifications to Active Transportation Element of Draft RPO Plan	This item was postponed.	None Required
4. Legislative Update	<p>Sam Klemm, WFRC, reviewed some of the transportation-related, proposed legislation being considered in the current state legislative session and the RPO discussed a few of the bills. A portion of state revenues allocated to transportation may be shifted to water needs. Sam noted that for now the Legislature does not appear likely to bond for additional transportation revenues.
