## SUMMER / FALL 2018 INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

**Job Title:** Planning Intern

**Supervisor:** Callie New

**Description:** Work internally with staff and management to provide assistance with regional planning activities in support of the Wasatch Choice 2050 Vision and 2019 Regional Transportation Plan. Potential to work with local agencies, jurisdictions, and partners. Provide assistance with land use, roadway, transit, and active transportation planning, including data analysis and evaluation, performance measures, financial planning, and other tasks as needed.

**Description:** Gather, analyze, and maintain geographic data relating to transportation and land use in the Wasatch Front. Assist in the creation of printed maps using ESRI ArcGIS software and online maps using ArcGIS Online. Provide technical GIS support to the development of the Regional Transportation Plan and Wasatch Choice 2050 vision. Other duties may include cleaning, organizing, and analyzing active transportation, green infrastructure, traffic, and demographic data for use in WFRC planning processes.
