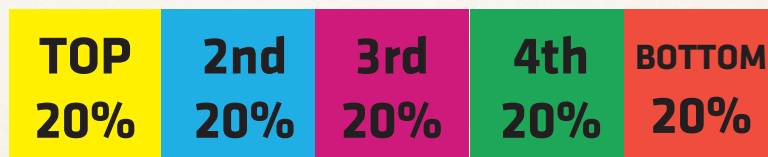
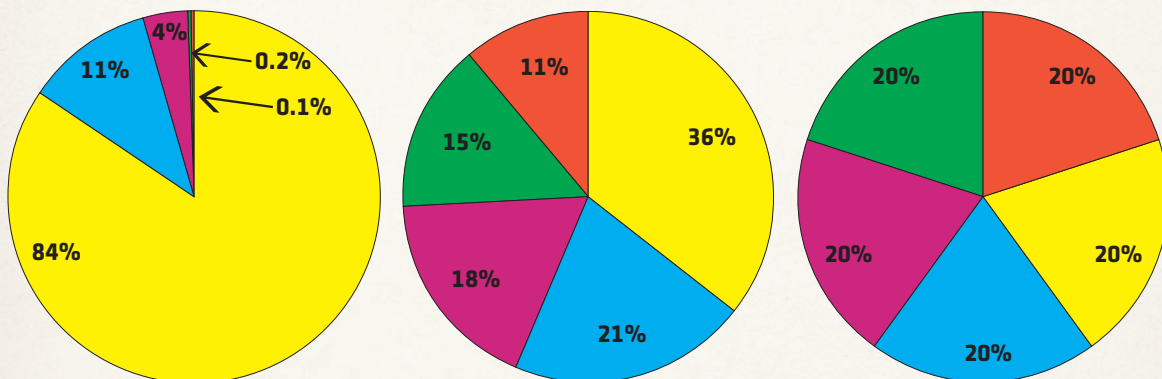
Intermountain States Populations: 1900-2010



U.S. Employment: 1998 - 2011

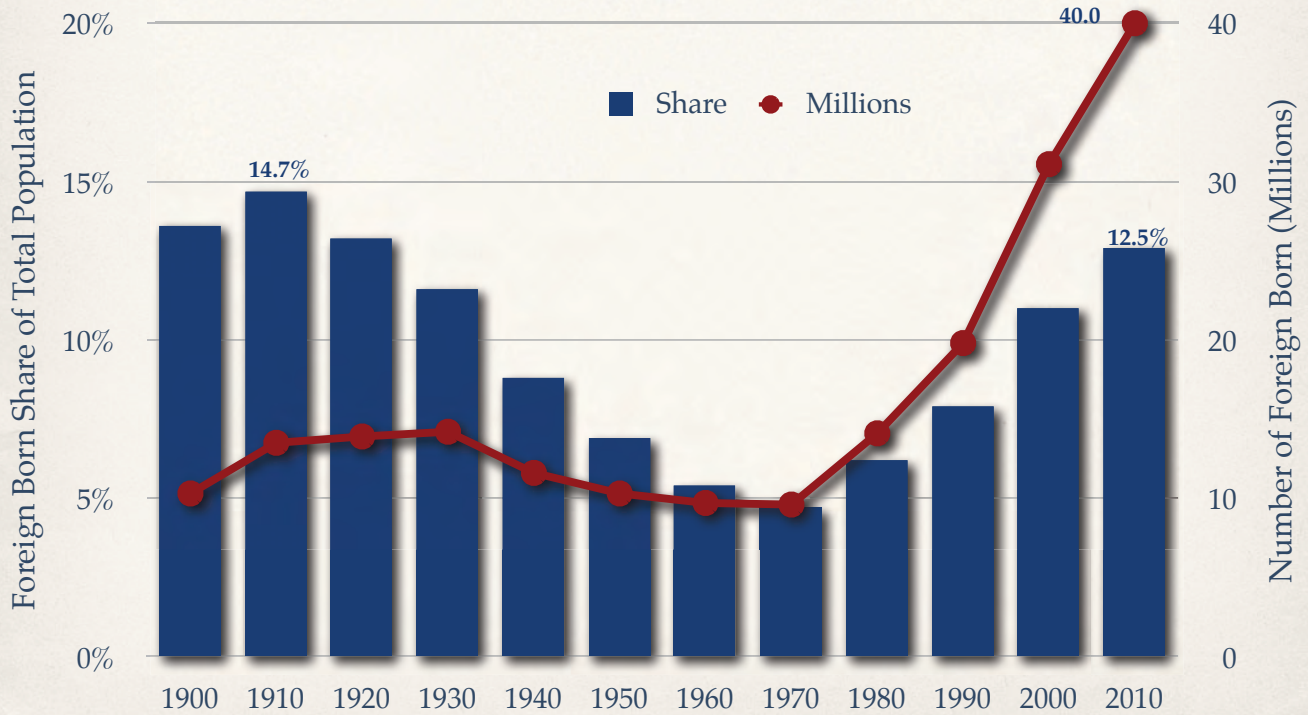


U.S. Sweden Equal



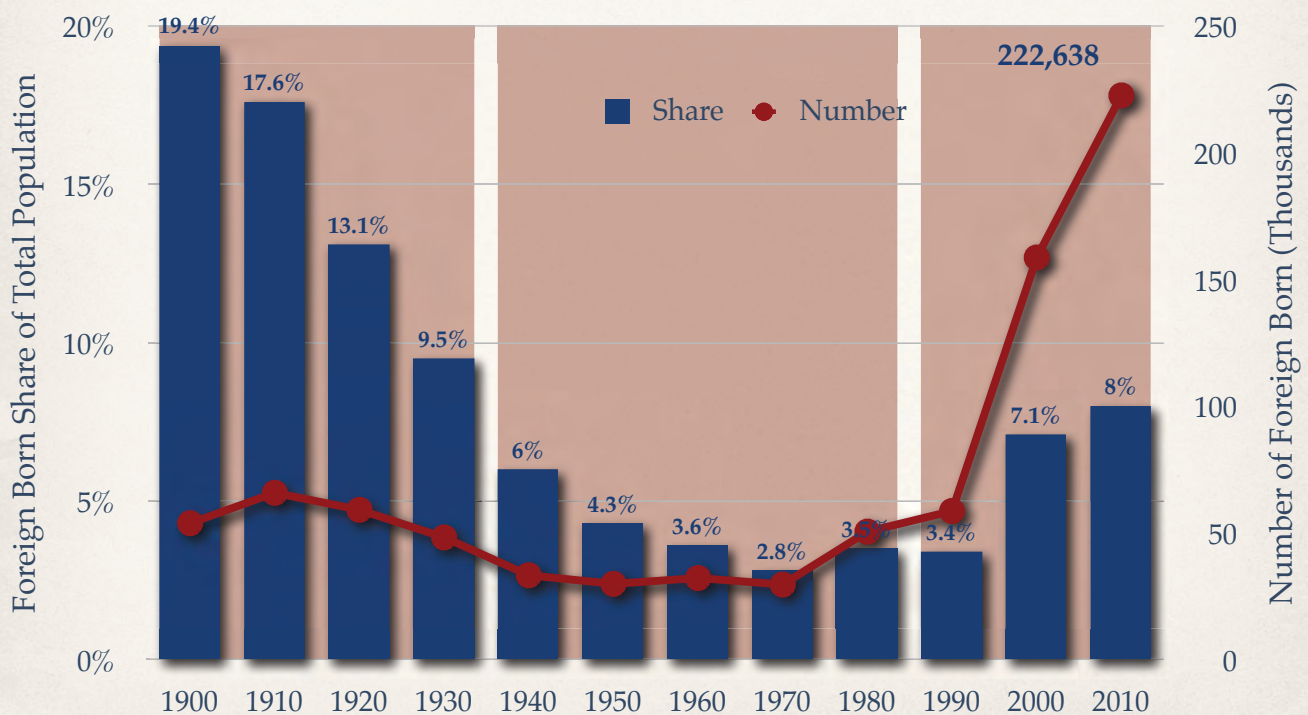

U.S. Foreign Born Population: 1900–2010



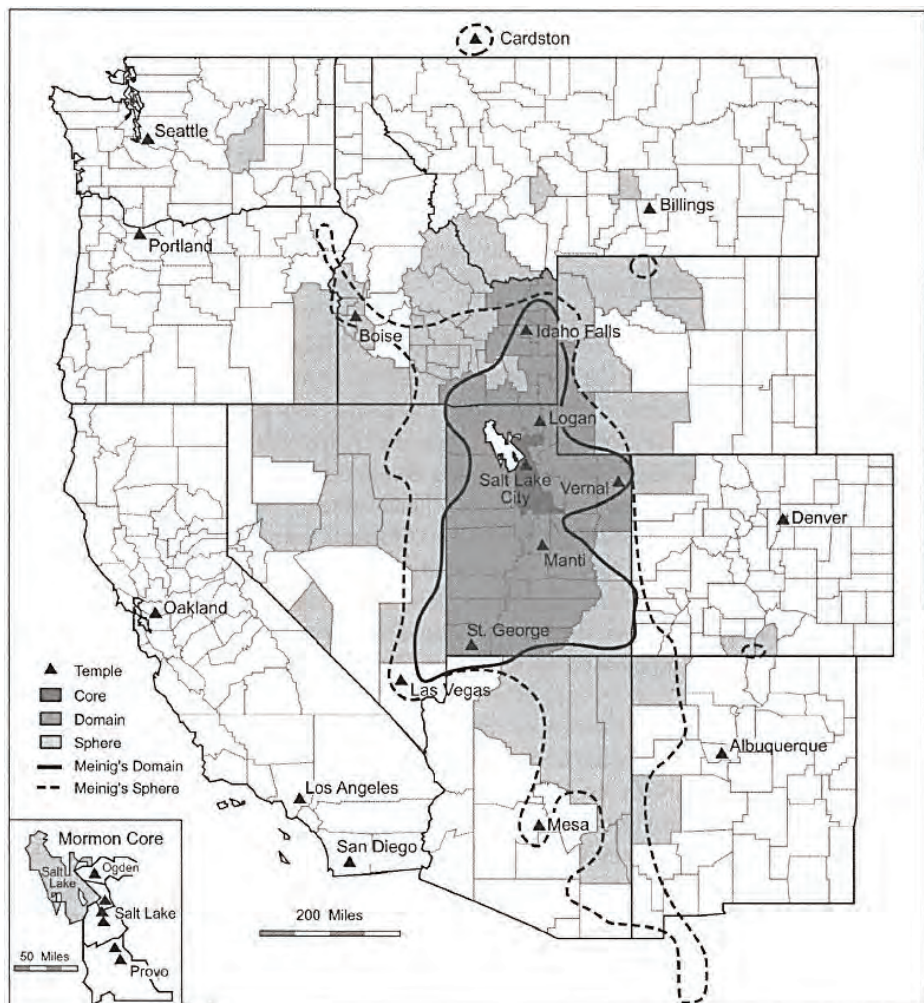
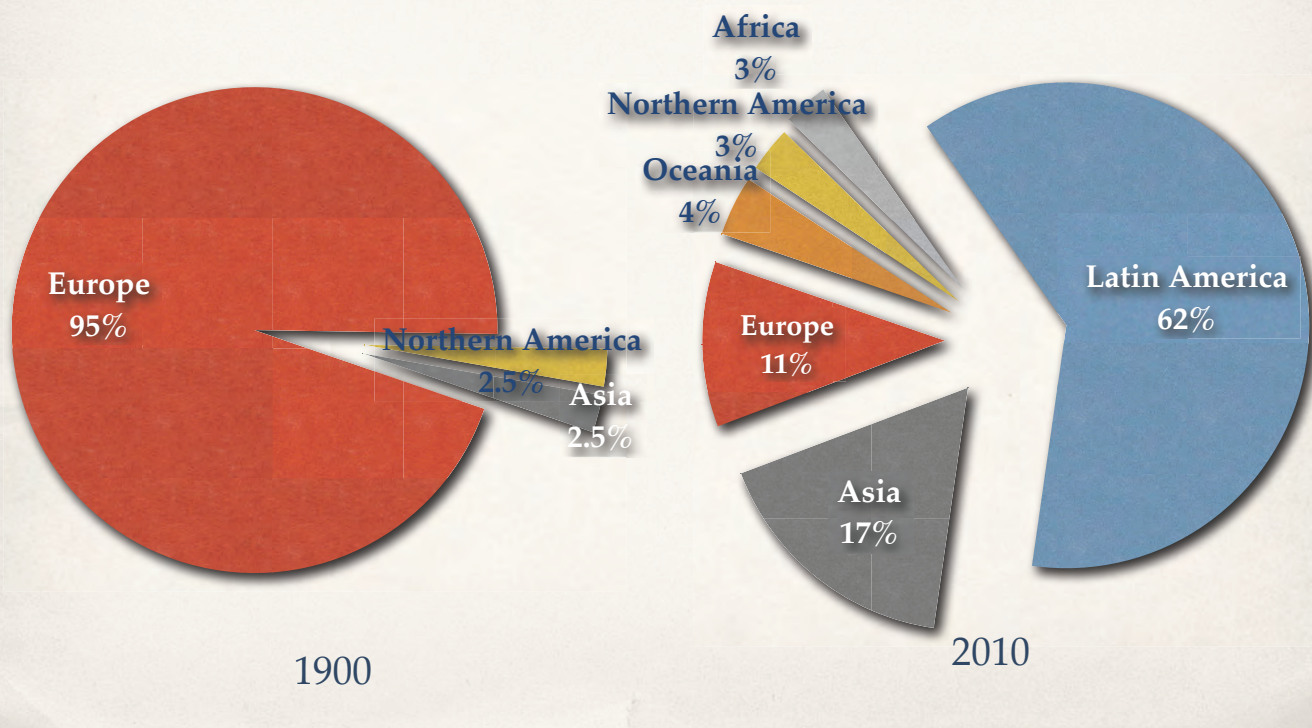

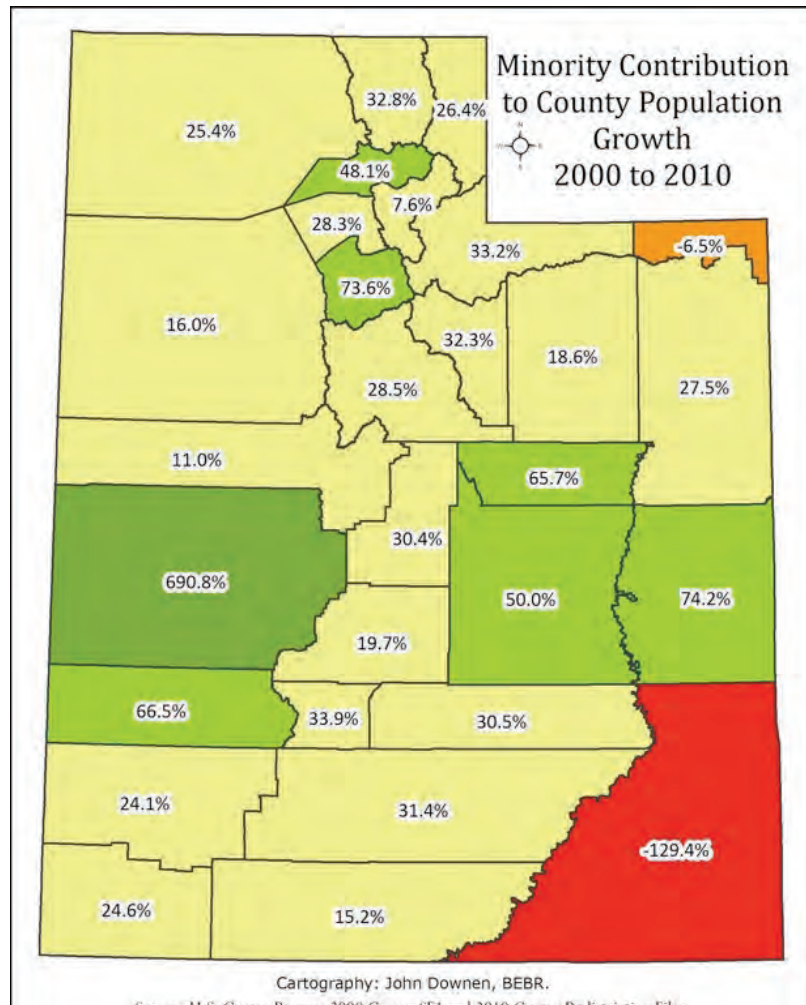
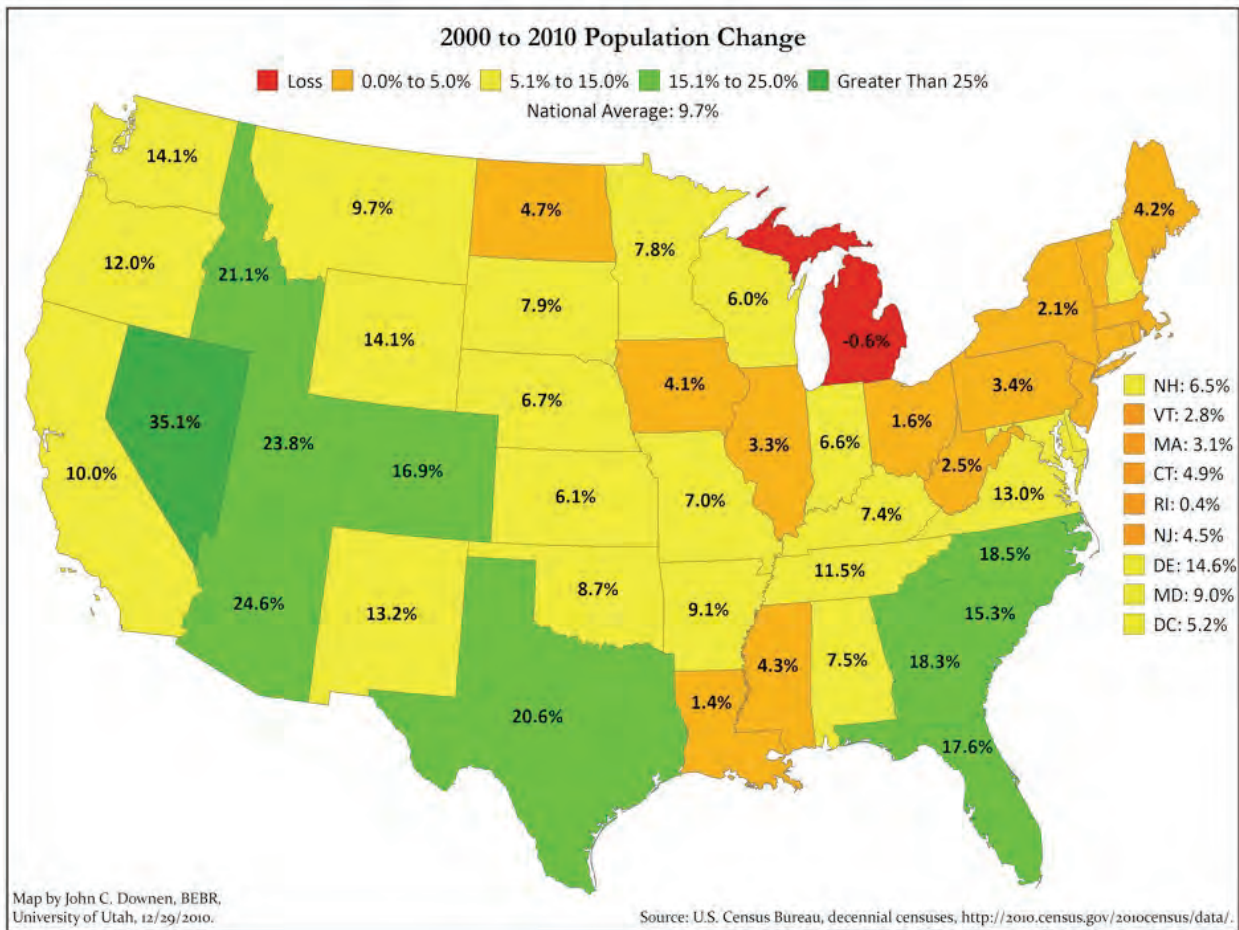
Utah Foreign Born Population: 1900–2010

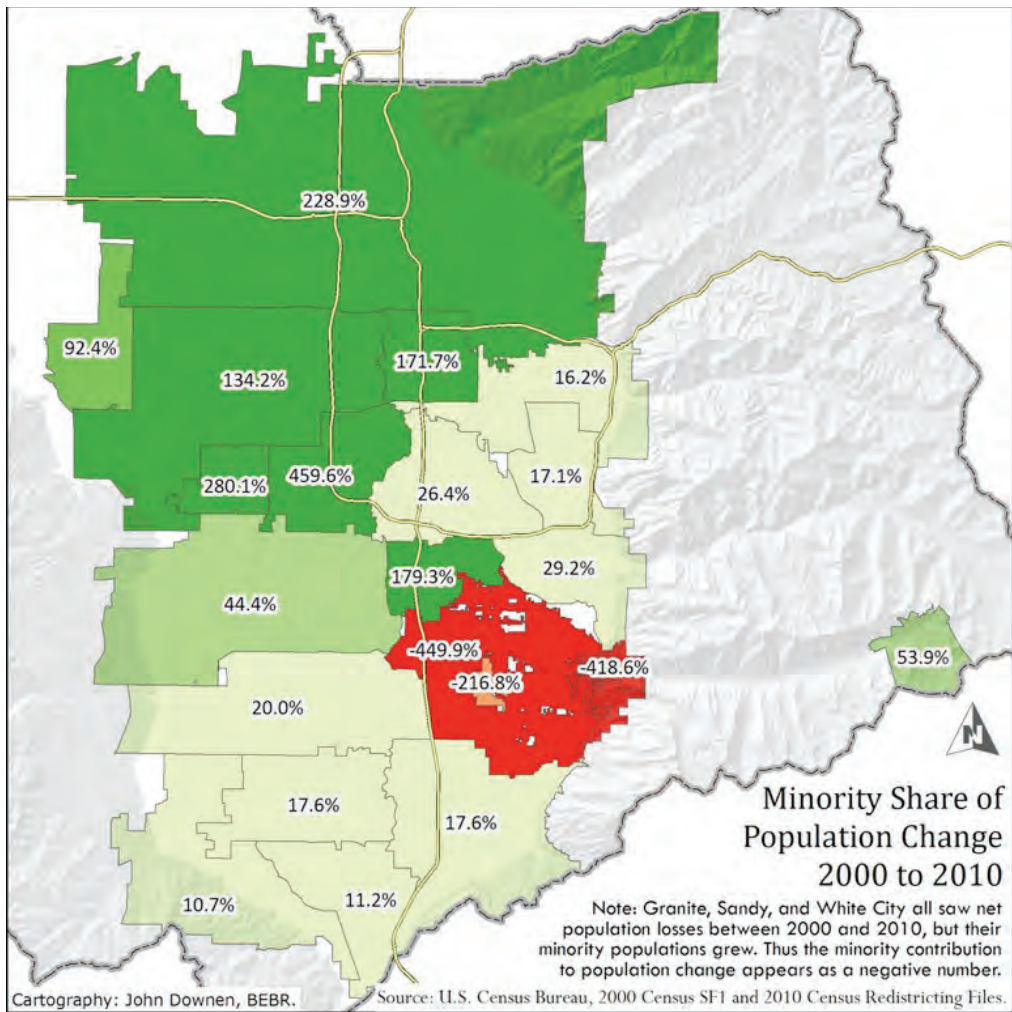

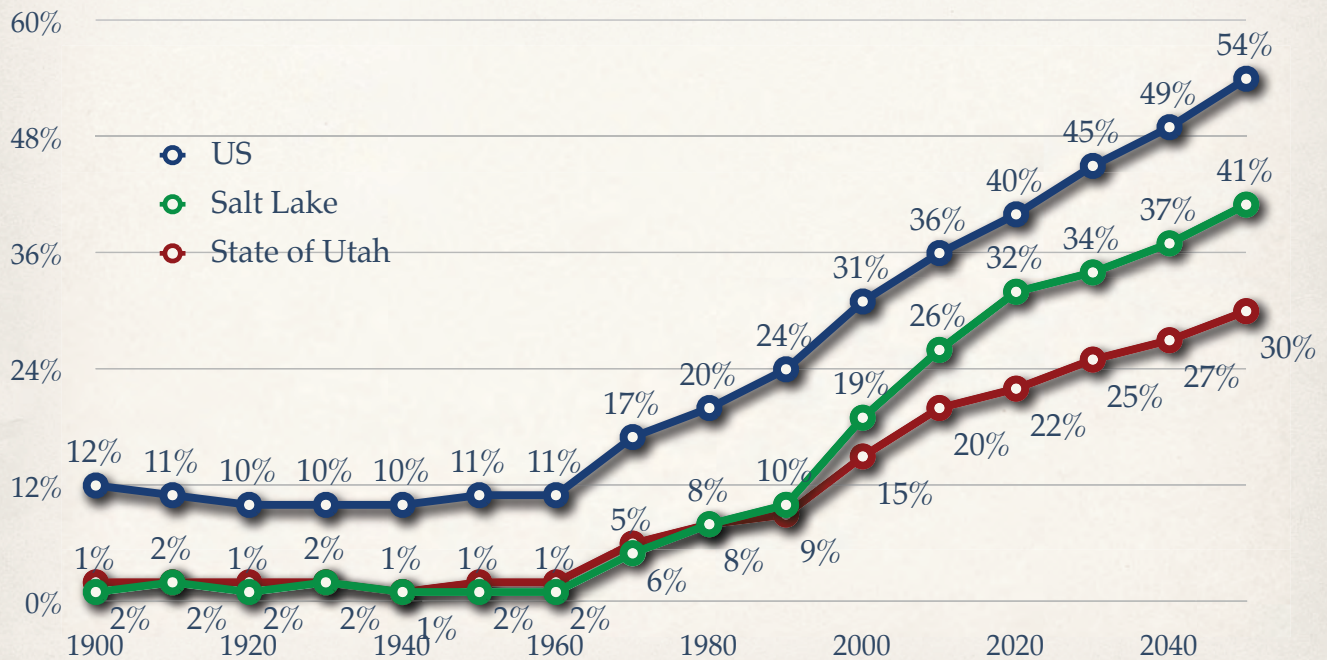
Utah's Foreign Born Population: 1900 v. 2010





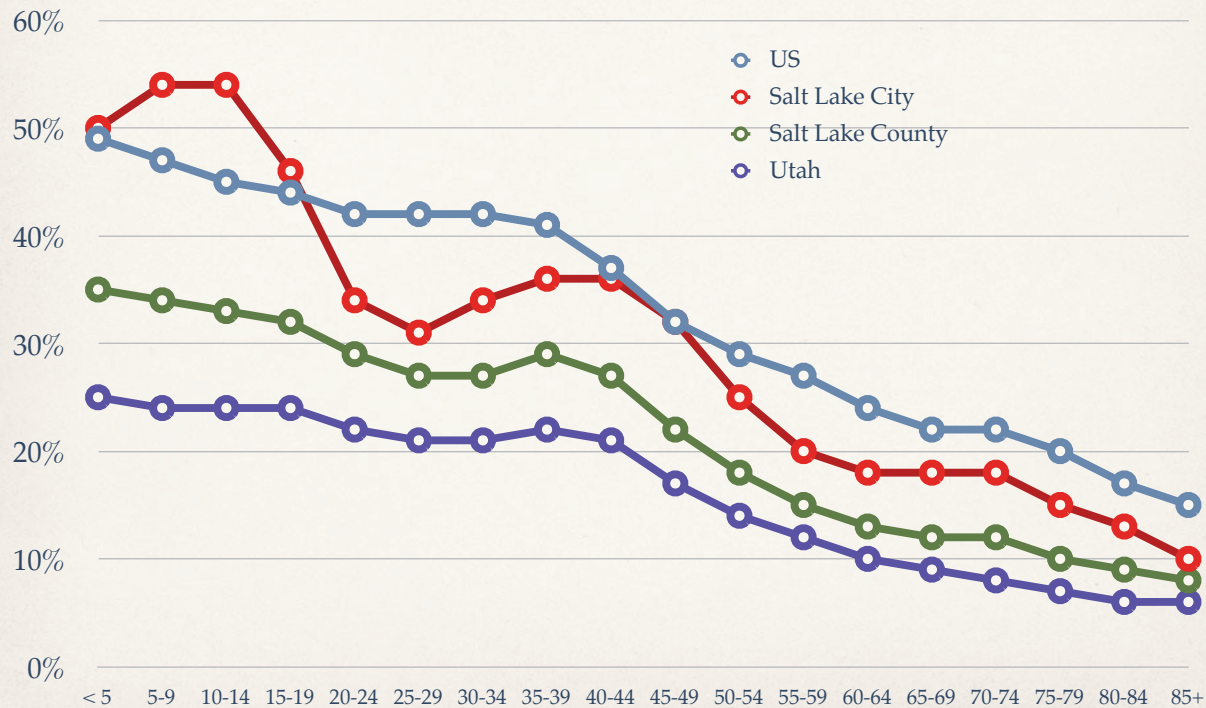


Minority Share of the Population: U.S., Utah, & Salt Lake County



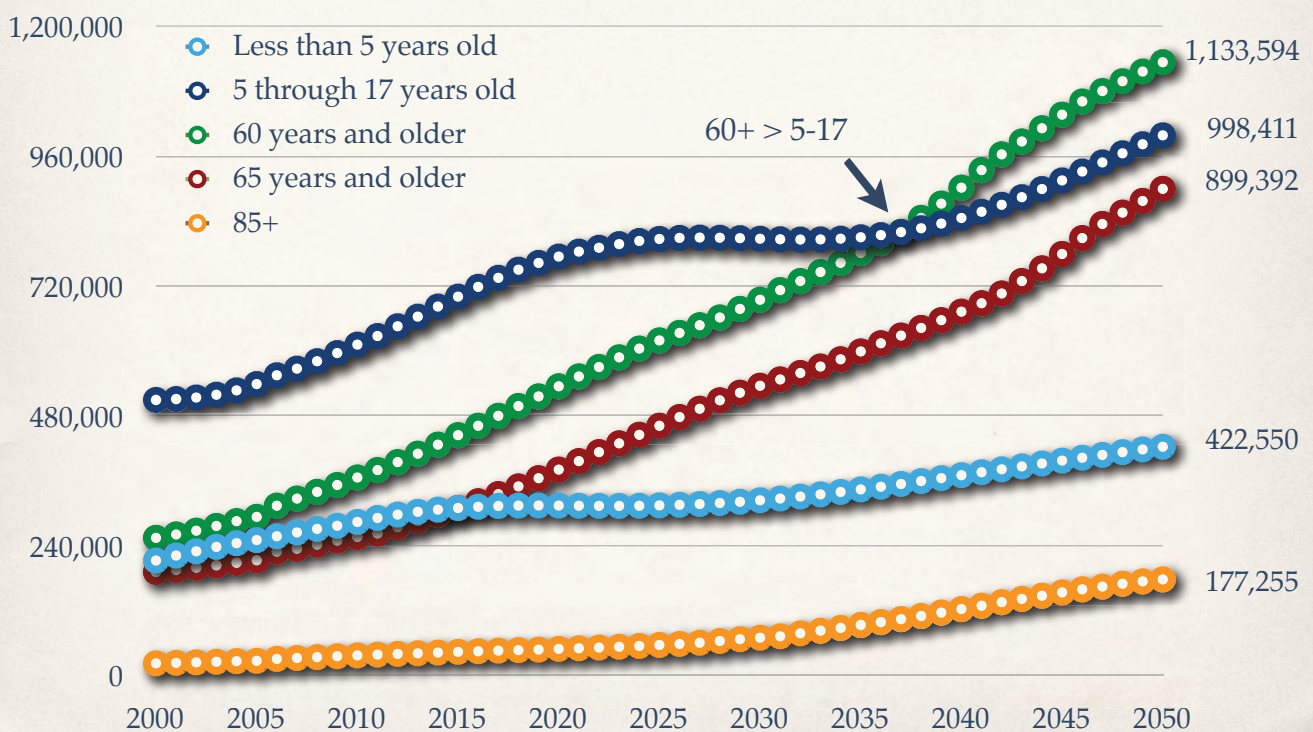

Minority Share by Age Group: 2010

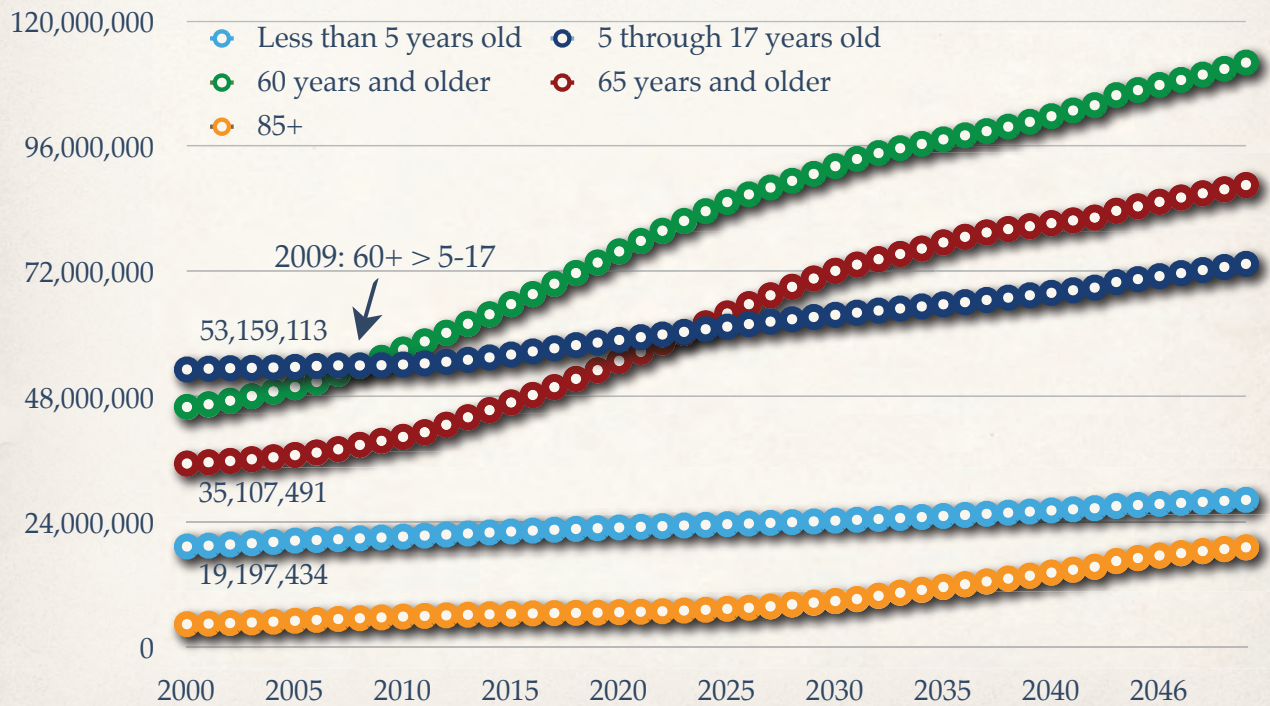
