

Utility Corridor Series Introduction

In order to ensure utility corridor preservation, they should be planned for with the proper rights of way or easements implemented. This will help reduce cost of expanding or building new utility lines and protects existing structures from being displaced. This series includes photos of several different utility corridors. While viewing these photos you may choose to consider how the following keywords apply to each photo. Then, consider how these keywords may apply to similar, present and future utility corridors within your community.

Utility Corridor Definition:

Rights-of-way or easements for utility lines on either publicly or privately owned property. (*California Planning Roundtable*)

Keywords:

coordinate development and maintenance, encourage cooperation and coordination with rights-of-way, identify future corridors into general plans and maps, infrastructure, preservation for future utility needs, transportation corridors
