1. <b>Approval of 04/13/14 Meeting Summary</b>	Commissioner Jerry Hurst made a motion to approve the April 13, 2014 meeting summary. Jerry Houghton, County Recorder, seconded the motion, and the committee voted unanimously.	Approved
2. <b>Tooele County Health Bicycle Update</b>	Malaena Toohey, Live Fit Coordinator for Tooele County Health Department, reported on competitive funding opportunities for bicycle facilities through the National Park Service. She noted that a local jurisdiction needs to have a bicycle plan in place in order to be able to apply. 3. <b>TravelWise Presentation</b>	Kim Clark, VIA Consulting, shared information about UDOT's TravelWise program. This program promotes transportation alternatives to help improve mobility and air quality, such as telecommuting, vanpooling, and active transportation. Kim reviewed the Community Resource Kit, which provides resources to local governments to aid in determining strategies appropriate for their communities. She also invited everyone to participate in the Clear the Air Challenge, which will take place in July (see cleartheairchallenge.org). 4. <b>Long Range Highway Phasing</b>	Wayne Bennion, WFRC, distributed maps showing preliminary congestion levels in 2025 based on a no build scenario and an interim build scenario. The comparison shows moderate improvement across the valley and significant improvement on SR-36, primarily due to the anticipated construction of Midvalley Highway.  The committee also reviewed a list of proposed highway improvements for the year 2040 that had been identified during previous RPO meetings and developed a preliminary recommended phasing for these improvements.  <b>Please contact Wayne Bennion at 801-363-4250 x1112 for more information.</b>	None Required
