<b>1. Approval of 06/13/16 Meeting Summary</b>	Patrick Cowley, UDOT, made a motion to approve the June 13, 2016 meeting summary. Larry Bolinder, Grantsville City, seconded the motion, and the committee voted unanimously.	Approved
<b>2. Active Transportation Phasing</b>	Wayne Bennion, WFRC, distributed an updated map showing draft active transportation phasing for the RPO Plan based on RPO discussion in April of Tooele County's updated Master Plan, and discussions with Tooele City and Grantsville City. The group discussed several of the trails shown. A recommendation was made to add a path to the Great Salt Lake Marina. It was also requested that the years of each phase be included in the legend. Wayne will send zoomed in sections for Grantsville, Tooele City, and Stansbury so that alignments can be reviewed. The group suggested that the UDOT Region 2 bicycle committee be given an opportunity to provide input.	None Required

There was agreement that it would be worthwhile to take the updated draft RPO Plan to City Councils and the County Commission.
