

Planning Data and Resources

Utah Automated Geographic Reference Center (AGRC)

The source provides a wealth of spatial information useful for planning. Data available for direct database connection or download includes:

- Aerial Photography (current and historic aerial photography)
- Land Ownership (private lands, public lands, wilderness, and SITLA)
- Boundaries (city, county, parcel, political districts, zip codes, tax zones, school districts, and PLSS)
- Demographics (2000 and 2010 Census)
- Elevation and Terrain (DEM, LiDAR, USGS Quads)
- Energy (coal, oil, gas, uranium)
- Environmental (DEQ air, land, and water cleanup sites)
- Geoscience (aquifers, debris flows, liquefaction and landslides, other hazards, and soils)
- Location (address points, building footprints, place names)
- Natural Resources (hydrology, wetlands, wildlife, vegetation, and FEMA flood zones)
- Transportation (airports, railroads, roads and highway system, transit)
- Utilities (broadband, electrical transmission, telephone infrastructure)
