SUBJECT: Request for Project Evaluation Concept Reports and/or Applications

The Wasatch Front Regional Council (WFRC) is now requesting concept reports and/or applications from those that submitted a Letter of Intent to the Urban Surface Transportation Program (STP) for Fiscal Year 2023 (FY23), the Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality (CMAQ) Program (FY23), the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) (FY19), and/or the Transportation and Land Use Connection Program (TLC)* (FY17).

**Concept reports and/or applications are due
to WFRC by Thursday, January 19, 2017**

By **clicking on the project funding source identified in the spreadsheet**, you can access the appropriate form(s) you will need to submit to apply for assistance. The forms vary by funding program.

Please keep in mind if you have filled out a concept report or application in the past, **the forms have been updated** and you will be required to complete and submit a new concept report. If for some reason you cannot download the appropriate form, contact Ben (STP, CMAQ, TAP) or Julia (TLC).

In order for WFRC staff to properly review and evaluate each project, please fill out the necessary forms completely according to the instructions and provide the required documentation. Due to the large number of potential projects to be submitted, **failure to properly fill out the required forms and submit the requested material by January 19th may result in the submitted project being removed from project evaluation and consideration.**

For those who may submit multiple projects to be considered for STP, CMAQ, TAP, and TLC funds, please prioritize your project submittals and consider submitting no more than three or four total projects. This will help to streamline the evaluation process and ensure your entity's highest priorities are considered.
