# 1. Roll Call and Consent Agenda [00:00:01]

Mayor Troy Walker, Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:32 am. He stated that he will be available until 10:00 am. At that time, he will turn the meeting over to Mayor Joy Petro, Vice Chair, who will proceed with the meeting.

# a. ACTION: Approval of Minutes [00:10:59]

Mayor Walker entertained a motion to approve the minutes of the Active Transportation Committee meeting held on <u>February 9, 2022</u>. A motion was made by Mayor Petro, seconded by Commissioner Blaine Fackrell, that the minutes be approved without changes. The affirmative motion carried unanimously.

# 2. Chair Report

### a. \$40 from Legislature for paved pathways [00:03:16]

Mayor Walker reported that this historic state investment from the Legislature in active transportation will require a 20 percent match, resulting in at least \$48 million being spent on active transportation projects throughout Utah. Added to last year's \$42 million in state commitment including local match, that equates to \$90 million over the past two years. He stated that if other local and federal funding are included, Utah is making a truly historic investment of well over \$100 million in active transportation.

# b. May is Bike Month – what is happening in your community? [00:04:55]

Mayor Walker opened this time to the group and gave members an opportunity to share what their communities are doing in celebration of Bike month.

### 3. Public Comment [00:11:40]

Mayor Walker opened the meeting for public comment. There were none.

#### 4. ACTION: 2022 Active Transportation Committee Focus Areas [00:12:00]

Hugh Van Wagenen, WFRC, displayed the draft 2022 Active Transportation Focus Areas that were discussed at the February meeting. Mr. Van Wagenen has incorporated the feedback from that discussion, and other suggestions, into the new set of focus areas. [00:13:28] Mayor Walker requested a motion to approve the updated 2022 Active Transportation Focus Areas as presented. Mayor Petro made the motion to approve, seconded by Mayor Travis Mote. The affirmative vote was unanimous.

# 5. The Golden Spoke: 100+ miles of trails connecting Provo to Ogden [00:14:15] (Goal 3: Educate)

Mr. Van Wagenen gave an overview of the <u>Golden Spoke</u> trail network and the <u>Golden Spoke</u> ride event happening on May 14, 2022.

# 6. ParkRx Utah introduction [00:26:35]

(Goal 3: Educate)

Sarah Kinnison introduced the Committee to <u>ParkRx Utah</u>, a free program that prescribes nature as a medicine for individuals to manage their health care.

# 7. Transportation Land Use Connection (TLC) awards (Goal 1: Plan) [00:47:37]

Megan Townsend, WFRC, presented the most recent Transportation Land Use Connection <u>awarded projects</u> related to active transportation.

### Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) overview (Goal 2: Build) [00:57:19]

Mr. Van Wagenen gave an overview of the active transportation-related <u>applications</u> being recommended for funding by the Transportation Coordinating Committee Technical Advisory Committee.

### 8. Other Business [01:09:39]

### a. WFRC Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) Update

Jory Johner, WFRC, gave a brief update on the <u>Regional Transportation Plan</u> process. He reported that WFRC staff is in the process of reviewing the draft 2023-2050 Regional Transportation Plan phased by need, and invited the group to provide feedback on this interactive map: https://wfrc.org/rtp-2023-needs-phase-map.
