1. Roll Call and Consent Agenda [00:00:01]

Mayor Troy Walker, Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:32 am and welcomed committee members and guests. Rosie Hernandez, WFRC, initiated a roll call.

2. Chair Report

a. Upcoming Events [00:03:13]

Mayor Walker reported on a couple of events that will be taking place before the next Active Transportation Committee meeting, and encouraged everyone to attend. The first is the Utah Pedestrian Summit, on September 14, 2022, at the Utah Valley Convention Center, and the second is the Mobile Active Transportation Tour, on October 4, 2022, in Park City.

3. Public Comment [00:06:25]

Mayor Walker opened the meeting for public comment. Councilmember Ellen Birrell, Cottonwood Heights, inquired about the recent bill that was passed by the Senate concerning climate change. She asked if there were funding opportunities for municipalities to come out of that bill related to active transportation. Hugh Van Wagenen, WFRC, reported that there may not be adequate funding for active transportation from that specific bill, however, there is funding for active transportation from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA). [00:07:45] Richard Crossley, Operations Manager for Lime, reported that since the June 8, 2022, ATC meeting, Lime has deployed over 300 e-bikes in Clearfield, Hill Air Force Base, and in Salt Lake City. 4. Update: First Last Mile 2.0 Project List [00:08:54]

Clint Campbell, UDOT, gave an overview of a multi-agency collaborative effort to identify and fund projects that connect more people to transit opportunities via biking and walking.

5. Presentation: Walkability Action Institute - Midvale City [00:16:05]

Mercedes Maestas, Salt Lake County Health Department, presented on a multidisciplinary team created by the City of Midvale, in an effort to attend general learning sessions with the National Association of Chronic Disease Directors, staff, develop team action plans, and implement Policy, Systems and Environmental outcomes, to create a walkability action plan for Main Street.

6. Presentation: Canal Corridor Trails Study [00:31:00]

Patrick Singleton, Utah State University, presented findings from a report outlining the possibility of utilizing more canal corridors for active transportation trails.

7. Presentation: Street Safety and Design [00:55:35]

Hugh Van Wagenen, WFRC, presented on how street design affects the safety of people using that street, whether walking, biking, or driving.

8. Update: Regional Transportation Plan - Fiscally Constrained Project Phasing [01:09:50] Jory Johner and Julie Bjornstad, WFRC, provided an update on Fiscally Constrained Project Phasing as part of the 2023 Regional Transportation Plan effort.
