- 1. Roll Call and Consent Agenda [00:00:02] At 9:47 am, Chair, Mayor Troy Walker welcomed all attendees.
 - a. <u>ACTION</u> [00:00:08] Mayor Walker asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the ATC meeting held June 14, 2023. Mayor Dirk Burton made a motion to approve the minutes, Mayor Dave Maughan seconded the motion. No discussion, the minutes were approved unanimously.
 - [00:00:49]: Roll call was taken around the room, Jordon read the online attendees.
- 2. Chair's Report [00:02:47] Mayor Walker gave a brief overview of the following items.
 - a. <u>RAISE grant award</u> June 2023, UDOT, MAG, UDOT, WFRC received a \$25 million reward to help improve the first and last mile for transit in 9 cities.
 - **b.** <u>TIF and TTIF nominations open</u> Nominations are open through the end of August. Contact Hugh Van Wagenen with questions. hugh@wfrc.org
 - c. <u>SS4A Safety Action Plan</u> WFRC has contracted with Kimberly Horn Consultants to prepare a comprehensive Safety Action Plan. The CSAP is a plan to provide local governments with strategic roadway safety improvements. Contact Kip Billings with questions. kip@wfrc.org
 - **d.** <u>Sandy Mobile Active Transportation Tour</u> The Sandy MATT will take place on Friday August 11th, Bikes and scooters are available upon request.
- 3. Public comment [00:05:55] There were no public comments.
- 4. Wasatch centers bike network and Utah Trail Network updates [00:06:13] Mayor Walker turned the time over to Hugh Van Wagenen, WFRC, who gave an update on the Utah Trail Network which is the \$45 million in one time money, and \$45 million in ongoing funding. UDOT is putting together a new division, the Trails and Transit Division, that will head up this effort. [00:09:03] Hugh turned the time over to Julie Bjornstad, WFRC, who gave an overview of the wasatch centers bike network, which is a parallel effort to the Utah Trail Network that will help combine our region's city centers, and local access to other facilities for Utah's Active Transportation users.
- 5. Five principles of Dutch bicycle network design [00:12:27] Mayor Walker introduced Mike West, and Kim Struthers of Lehi City who discussed the five principles used in the Netherlands, which has led to their successful bicycle network design: cohesion, directness, safety, comfort, and attractiveness; and why each of these are important when focusing on Active Transportation in communities.
- 6. Department of Health Active Living [01:02:19] Brett McIff, Department of Healthy Active Living gave an overview of recent efforts that are being taken to encourage active living, which includes Active Transportation use. Mr. McIff touched on some of the statistics that help to support active living.
- 7. Bike Utah Connectivity Analyses [01:14:17] Chris Wiltsie and Ally Padgen of Bike Utah, discussed the analyses and formulas they are using to measure street connectivity in communities using the metrics of: the relative level of connection, network density, the ability to connect to destinations, and the quality of network for all users walkability; and how it pertains to active transportation.

- **9.** Other Business [01:27:17] Alex Beim with UTA announced that they are doing outreach for their long range transit plan.
