MINUTES WFRC || Active Transportation Committee April 8, 2025

WFRC Active Transportation Committee Meeting was held at WFRC Office, 41 N Rio Grande Street, Salt Lake City and via Zoom.

1. Introductions and consent agenda [00:00:20]

Mayor Troy Walker, Draper City, Chair of the Active Transportation Committee welcomed members and guests to the meeting. **ACTION:** [00:00:34] Mayor Walker requested a motion to approve the minutes from the February 11th, 2025 meeting. Jared Bowling, UDOT made the motion, and Carla Merrill, Alpine Mayor, seconded. There was no further discussion, and the motion passed unanimously. [00:01:18] Mayor Walker initiated a roll call, both in the room and online.

2. Chair report [00:06:07]

a. Golden Spoke Ride Mayor Walker introduced the Golden Spoke Ride, a free event scheduled for Saturday, May 10th, celebrating the eight trails connecting riders from Ogden to Provo. He provided an overview of the event routes, registration details, and volunteer opportunities.

3. Public comment [00:13:34]

4. Utah Trail Network Programmed Projects Update [00:14:24]

Stephanie Tomlin, Director of the Trails Division at UDOT, presented an update on the 19 projects currently funded within the Utah Trail Network, covering both the WFRC and MAG Regions. She highlighted that, while 19 projects are included in the current phase, additional projects are expected to be funded in subsequent phases.

5. Transportation & Land Use Connection 2025 Projects [00:35:52]

Byron Head, Community Planner at the Wasatch Front Regional Council, reviewed the communities and projects selected to receive Transportation and Land Use Connection technical assistance in 2025.

6. Bikeways existing Infrastructure Map [00:50:53]

Bert Granberg, Analytics Director at the Wasatch Front Regional Council, introduced a new ongoing effort to map existing bicycle infrastructure across the state of Utah. He highlighted the partners involved in the project and outlined the data that will be collected and shared through the new map, which is scheduled to launch in May 2025.

7. Legislative Session Summary [01:07:21]

Miranda Jones Cox, Government Affairs Manager at the Wasatch Front Regional Council, provided an update on the 2025 legislative session, focusing on bills related to Active Transportation. Angela Price from Salt Lake City discussed SB195, its impact on the city, and the plans for moving forward.

Mayor Walker announced that the next ATC meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, June 10th. Hugh Van Wagenen mentioned the upcoming Mobile Active Transportation Tour taking place in Jersey City and Hoboken, New Jersey.
