1. Welcome and Consent Agenda [00:00:08]

At 2:08pm, Council Chair Mayor Jeff Silvestrini welcomed the Wasatch Front Regional Council members and guests and introductions were made around the table and online via roll call. [00:04:16] Mayor Silvestrini noted the gathering of public attendees and their interest in Item 5 on the agenda, and clarified the action recommended for today's meeting - releasing the DRAFT 2023-2050 Regional Transportation Plan for public comment. He advised the group that there will be time for public comment later in the meeting. [00:08:20] **ACTION:** In order to move the meeting forward more efficiently, Mayor Silvestrini requested a motion to address the agenda items out of order. Commissioner Jim Harvey motioned to approve re-ordering the agenda as necessary, which was seconded by Mayor Mark Shepherd. The affirmative vote was unanimous.

3. Public Comment [00:09:38]

Mayor Silvestrini exercised the Chair's prerogative and extended the meeting's public comment period for 30 minutes. Attendance sheets listing in-person attendees, denoting those who provided comments, will be attached to this document of record. The names of the public attendees who joined the meeting virtually are listed below.

2. Chair Report [00:10:55]

2a. ACTION: Appointments to WFRC Council and Committees

The WFRC Bylaws require that a Chair and Vice Chair be elected bi-annually at the first regular meeting in odd number years. At the October 2022 WFRC meeting, WFRC Chair Mayor Jeff Silvestrini appointed a six-member Nominating Committee to propose a slate of officers for consideration. The Nominating Committee met in December 2022 and now presents recommendations for the following: South Jordan City Mayor Dawn Ramsey as Council Chair and Commissioner Bob Stevenson as Council Vice Chair for 2023-2024. [00:12:30] **ACTION:** A motion was made to accept these appointments by Mayor Mark Shepherd and was seconded by Mayor Troy Walker. Voting in the affirmative was unanimous. At Mayor Ramsey's request, Mayor Silvestrini continued to chair this meeting, rather than turning it over to her, as she was attending remotely. [00:15:47] The WFRC Chair has made appointments of WFRC Members to the Regional Growth Committee (RGC), Transportation Coordinating Committee (Trans Com), WFRC Budget Committee, Active Transportation Committee (ATC), and Joint Policy Advisory Committee (JPAC). Appointments to WFRC and its Committees have also been made by the County Councils of Governments (COGs) and other appointing authorities that partner with WFRC. Updated WFRC Council and Committee membership lists were distributed at the meeting and will be posted on WFRC's website. [00:17:20] **ACTION:** Commissioner Bob Stevenson made a motion that the members of the Council endorse the appointments to WFRC Council and other Committees as listed. Mayor Dirk Burton seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous. The newly appointed members briefly introduced themselves.

3. Public Comment continued [00:20:13]

1. Consent Agenda continued [00:57:53]

Mayor Silvestrini returned to Item 1, and the minutes of the WFRC meeting held October 27, 2022, the Financial Statements for Sept, Oct, and Nov 2022 and the current Budget/Expenditure Report. **ACTION:** Mayor Mike Caldwell made a motion to approve and Mayor Jenny Wilson seconded the motion. The minutes and financial statements were accepted unanimously.

2. Chair Report continued [00:59:05]

Mayor Silvestrini reported that several members of WFRC leadership and staff, along with some partners at Mountainland Association of Governments, attended the National Association of Regional Councils in Washington DC to learn best practices about working regionally and how to best take advantage of the federal programs and policies that relate to transportation, and housing, among other topics.

2b. ACTION: Legislative session report and endorse positions on legislation [01:02:48]

Mayor Silvestrini introduced Miranda Jones Cox, WFRC, who briefed the Council on several pertinent bills, focusing on key transportation, housing, and growth items, that are being tracked during this Legislative Session. [01:04:21] Mayor Silvestrini asked Ms. Jones Cox to pause her presentation for a brief statement from Mayor Erin Mendenhall. [01:07:53] Mayor Silvestrini turned the time back to Ms. Jones Cox to complete her presentation. She, along with Carlos Braceras, UDOT, commented on legislation that would expand the Utah Trails Network. Members of the Council were encouraged to provide their support by signing a letter supporting this initiative. [01:18:53] **ACTION:** Mayor Silvestrini entertained a motion to endorse the recommended positions as discussed. Mayor Troy Walker made the motion and Mayor Dirk Burton seconded. The position approvals were accepted unanimously.

5. Regional Growth Committee (RGC) [01:19:35]

5a. ACTION: Release DRAFT 2023-2050 Regional Transportation Plan for public comment

Mayor Silvestrini brought attention to Item 5 and invited Mayor Dawn Ramsey, RGC Chair, to give a report. Mayor Ramsey briefly reviewed the process for updating the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) and then introduced Jory Johner, WFRC, who reported more in-depth on the progress of the RTP, in preparation for releasing it for public comment. [01:33:15] Mayor Ramsey noted that there was a good discussion on the RTP during the RGC meeting held on January 19 and turned the time to Andrew Gruber, WFRC, to summarize that information. [01:37:40] **ACTION:** Mayor Ramsey noted that there will be more opportunity for discussion among the Council members and alternates, and then made a motion to release the draft phased and financially constrained 2023-2050 Regional Transportation Plan and draft Air Quality Memorandum #41 for public comment from January 27, 2023 to February 26, 2023. Salt Lake County Councilmember Aimee Winder Newton seconded the motion. Since UDOT is responsible for the Little Cottonwood Canyon Environmental Impact Study (EIS), Mayor Silvestrini invited Carlos Braceras, UDOT, to make comments regarding the RTP. After a request from Commissioner Bob Stevenson, how to participate in the 30-day public comment process was outlined by Mr. Johner. [01:43:55] Mayor Monica Zoltanski made a substitute motion to approve the RTP as presented, but remove the language anticipating the gondola phase of Little Cottonwood Canyon funding. Mayor Jenny Wilson suggested an amendment to the substitute motion to include removing all additional funding line items associated with the gondola/Little Cottonwood Canyon, (the entirety of the transportation-related projects that were identified in the Little Cottonwood Canyon Environmental Impact Study (EIS) Phase 1, Phase 2, and Phase 3), which Mayor Zoltanski accepted. Mayor Wilson seconded the substitute motion. There was more discussion among the Council members. [02:07:45] **ACTION:** Mayor Silvestrini called for a roll call vote from the 19 members and designated alternates present, on the substitute motion. There were five affirmative votes and 14 votes against the substitute motion. With no majority, the substitute motion did not carry. [02:11:18] **ACTION:** Mayor Silvestrini then called for a roll call vote from the 19 members and designated alternates present, on the original motion. There were 15 affirmative votes and four votes against the original motion. With a majority vote, the motion to release the draft phased and financially constrained 2023-2050 Regional Transportation Plan and draft Air Quality Memorandum #41 for public comment from January 27, 2023 to February 26, 2023 was approved.

5b. ACTION: Certify Salt Lake City's Ballpark Station Area Plan (SAP) [02:13:32]

Mayor Ramsey reminded the group about HB462, which was adopted last legislative session to help address Utah's challenges with housing availability and affordability. She introduced a

three-minute video that highlighted the tremendous progress being made in communities around the region to promote and enable growth in city and town centers. [02:19:10] Mayor Ramsey then turned the time over to Megan Townsend, WFRC, to discuss the process and some of the requirements for reviewing and approving Station Area Plans. Ms. Townsend brought attention to the pertinent meeting materials and highlighted Salt Lake City's Ballpark SAP, which has been put forth for certification in this meeting. Ms. Townsend notified the Council that, at their meeting on January 19, the Regional Growth Committee took action to make a recommendation to the Council to approve this SAP, and turned the time back over to Mayor Ramsey. Mayor Ramsey invited Salt Lake City Councilmember Dan Dugan to share any thoughts. [02:25:05] **ACTION:** Mayor Ramsey made a motion to certify Salt Lake City's Ballpark Station Area Plan, which was seconded by Councilmember Dugan. The affirmative vote was unanimous.

4. Transportation Coordinating Committee (Trans Com) [02:26:35]

Mayor Mark Shepherd, Trans Com Chair, informed the Council of the items that were discussed in the Trans Com meeting held on February 16, 2023.

4a. Board Modifications to 2023-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Mayor Shepherd noted that since the last meeting of the Council, WFRC staff received requests to modify the current 2023-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The modification required action from Trans Com (since WFRC was not meeting) and the Utah Transportation Commission, but did not require a new air quality conformity analysis or a 30-day public comment period. The modification is included in the meeting materials, and Mayor Shepherd stated that if there were any questions, Ben Wuthrich, WFRC, would be available to answer them.

4b. ACTION: Board Modifications to 2023-2028 TIP [02:27:05]

Mayor Shepherd then reported that WFRC staff has again received several requests to modify the current 2023-2028 TIP and this list of projects is also included in the meeting materials. Mayor Shepherd turned the time to Ben Wuthrich, WFRC, who briefly discussed each project. [02:38:21] **ACTION:** Mayor Mark Shepherd made a motion to approve the resolution to modify the 2023-2028 TIP as requested. Mayor Mike Caldwell seconded the motion and the voting was unanimous in the affirmative.

6. WFRC Budget Committee [02:38:52]

6a. ACTION: Approve updates to WFRC Accounting and Administrative Policy

Mayor Silvestrini invited Mayor Mike Caldwell, Chair of the WFRC Budget Committee, to give a report. Mayor Caldwell turned the time to Marian Florence, WFRC, who provided a review of the updates made to WFRC's Administrative and Accounting Policy.

WFRC has made the following updates to its financial processes, now reflected in the Policy:

- An Accounting Specialist has joined the WFRC staff, providing increased internal control and capacity.
- WFRC has upgraded its accounting software to a system specifically designed for municipalities and local governments.
- Payroll is now processed in house, not by a third party.
- Payments are made by ACH, not by physical check.

Other updates to the language further defining WFRC's processes, as well as all the components currently addressed in the existing Policy, have been incorporated into the proposed updated Policy with updated language. [02:41:40] Mayor Caldwell made a motion to approve the updated WFRC Accounting and Administrative Policy. Commissioner Bob Stevenson seconded the motion and the affirmative vote was unanimous.

7. Reports [02:42:25]

7a. Wasatch Front Economic Development District (WFEDD) update

Commissioner Gage Froerer, WFEDD Chair, had to leave the meeting, so Mayor Silvestrini asked Andrew Gruber, WFRC, to provide an update on the Wasatch Front Economic Development District committee.

7b. Executive Director report [02:43:06]

Andrew Gruber, WFRC, thanked those serving on WFRC's committees, and stated his appreciation for their engagement on these important issues.

8. Video: Overview of the Utah Open and Public Meeting Act [02:43:39]

With no further business, Mayor Silvestrini stated that since Utah State law requires that elected officials serving on committees such as those of the Wasatch Front Regional Council receive training regarding the Utah Open and Public Meetings Act, an 8-minute video will now be shown in order to comply with this requirement. Mayor Silvestrini made a motion to adjourn the meeting upon completion of the training video, and Mayor Mike Caldwell seconded. The affirmative vote was unanimous.

8. Other Business and Adjournment [02:44:19]

Technical difficulties with the video did not allow the Open and Public Meetings Act recording to be captured. The meeting adjourned at 4:53pm.
