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1. Welcome and Consent Agenda [00:00:05]

At 2:06pm, Council Chair Mayor Dawn Ramsey welcomed the Wasatch Front Regional Council members and guests. Introductions were made around the table, and online via roll call. [00:04:08] ACTION: Mayor Ramsey brought attention to the first item on the agenda - the minutes of the August 24, 2023 meeting and Financial statements and check registers for July and August 2023 and Budget/Expenditure Report to date. Mayor Bob Dandoy made a motion to approve all the documents as written and UTA Trustee Carlton Christensen seconded the motion. There was no discussion and the minutes and financial statements were approved unanimously.

2. Chair Report [00:05:00]

a. Update and preview - growth policy and legislation

Mayor Ramsey informed the Council that with the 2024 legislative session approaching, policy discussions are underway, within groups such as the Unified Economic Opportunity Commission and various interim committees. [00:07:30] Mayor Ramsey invited Utah House Representative Calvin Mussleman, who also serves on WFRC Council, to provide an update on some of the recommendations and priorities coming out of those discussions that relate to WFRC's work. [00:16:40] Mayor Ramsey then introduced Miranda Jones Cox, Government Affairs Manager at WFRC, who shared more information about additional policy proposals that are currently under consideration.

b. ACTION: Approve WFRC's Title VI Plan, Public Participation Plan (PPP), and Limited English Proficiency (LEP) Plan [00:29:28]

Mayor Ramsey turned the time to Andrew Gruber, Executive Director at WFRC, to present the updates to the 2023 Title VI Plan and related documents. [00:30:30] Mr. Gruber introduced Lauren Victor, WFRC Transportation Planner, who presented a brief outline of the updates. [00:32:40] ACTION: Mayor Ramsey entertained a motion to approve WFRC's updated 2023 Title VI Plan, updated Public Participation Plan, and updated Limited English Proficiency Plan as presented. Commissioner Bob Stevenson made a motion, which was seconded by Mayor Mike Caldwell. There was no further discussion and the vote to approve was unanimous.

3. Public Comment [00:33:04]

Mayor Ramsey opened the meeting for public comment. Prior to the inviting comments from the public, Mayor Ramsey recognized Ogden City Mayor Mike Caldwell, for 12 years of service to the community and WFRC. Mayor Caldwell will not be running for re-election, so subsequently will no longer be serving on any of WFRC's committees. [00:38:10] Steve Van Maren, Sandy City resident, provided a comment about the ZAP (Zoo, Arts, & Parks) tax. [00:39:54] Salt Lake County Mayor Jenny Wilson commented on the ZAP tax as well. [00:41:00] Mayor Ramsey expressed appreciation for the Utah Transportation Conference (UTC), formerly known as the UDOT Conference, and asked Carlos Braceras, UDOT Executive Director, to make some remarks about the conference. [00:48:35] Andrew Gruber noted that at the UTC Conference, Bill Hereth, WFRC Analytics Engineer, received an award for his work on creating more user-friendly technology which improves decision making in implementing transportation solutions.

4. Wasatch Front Economic Development District (WFEDD) [00:50:45]

a. ACTION: Concur on the adoption of the 2023-2028 Regional Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS)

Mayor Ramsey turned the time to Commissioner Gage Froerer who provided an update on the current CEDS document. The WFEDD recently completed the 2023-2028 Regional Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy or CEDS. This process took seven months to complete with extensive outreach to stakeholders including government officials, private-sector business and economic development organizations, local and state government economic development staff, and public input. The work by WFRC and the WFEDD is meant to complement and support the work done by the cities and counties and other economic development organizations. [00:54:15] Commissioner Froerer introduced Marcia White, WFRC, who, along with Trina Kittleson, Better City, gave a

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presentation highlighting key points in the CEDS and the impact it will have on implementing the Wasatch Choice Vision. With its strategy of centered development, this approach will promote long-term, sustainable economic development and opportunity in our communities. **[01:05:05] ACTION:** Commissioner Froerer made a motion that the Wasatch Front Regional Council concur with the WFEDD on the adoption of the 2023-2028 Regional Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy. Commissioner Stevenson seconded the motion and the affirmative vote was unanimous.

5. Regional Growth Committee (RGC) [01:06:23]

a. Utah's Unified Transportation Plan 2023-2029

Mayor Ramsey directed the meeting to Mayor Bob Dandoy, Chair of RGC, for an update on RGC. Mayor Dandoy encouraged the group to attend the upcoming Wasatch Choice Vision Workshops that will be held throughout the valley over the next few weeks. These meetings are hosted jointly by WFRC, UDOT, and UTA, and will focus on implementation of the Wasatch Choice Vision. There will be discussion on parks and public spaces, water, housing and active transportation, particularly feedback to inform UDOT's development of the Utah Trail Network, along with the specific results for each workshop area that have come from the Guiding our Growth public process. [01:09:25] Mayor Dandoy then introduced Jory Johner, WFRC, who provided an overview of the progress and process of Utah's Unified Transportation Plan.

6. Transportation Coordinating Committee (Trans Com) [01:24:43]

Mayor Mark Shepherd, Trans Com Chair, introduced Ben Wuthrich, WFRC, who will discuss modifications requested for the TIP.

a. ACTION: Board Modifications to the 2024-2029 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Mr Wuthrich reported that since the last meeting of Wasatch Front Regional Council, WFRC received requests to modify the current 2024-2029 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), and briefly described each modification. [01:37:05] ACTION: Mayor Shepherd made a motion to approve the modifications as discussed. Mayor Joy Petro seconded the motion and the affirmative vote was unanimous.

7. Budget Committee [01:37:35]

Mayor Ramsey then brought the group's attention to Mayor Mike Caldwell, WFRC Budget Committee Chair, for the WFRC Budget Committee report.

a. ACTION: Accept the FY23 WFRC Audit Report

Mayor Caldwell reported that the Council's financial statements for FY23 received an unqualified opinion with no findings or questioned costs. A copy of the audit report was included in the meeting material previously provided. A summary of the audit results can be found on page 47 of the report. The WFRC Budget Committee met to review the audit. Marian Florence, WFRC, and our independent auditors from Larson Certified Public Accountants, are here, to answer questions. [01:38:55] ACTION: Mayor Caldwell made a motion that the Council accept the FY23 audit report. Commissioner Lee Perry seconded the motion and the affirmative vote was unanimous.

b. PUBLIC HEARING and ACTION: Approve Fiscal Year 24 WFRC Budget amendments

[01:39:55] Mayor Caldwell made a motion to open a public hearing regarding approving amendments to the WFRC FY24 Budget. Commissioner Bob Stevenson seconded the motion. The affirmative vote was unanimous. [01:40:20] Mayor Caldwell stated that each year in October WFRC amends its budget to reflect the final financials from the previous year, and to include projects that were budgeted in the previous year but were not completed prior to the end of that year and are carried forward to the current fiscal year. This is a routine action, which reflects that many of WFRC's projects are multi-year in nature. [01:41:14] Mayor Ramsey asked if there were any comments from the public in attendance. Steve Van Maren, Sandy City resident, provided a comment/question about the projects where the funding was underspent. [01:42:07] Mayor Ramsey invited Marian Florence, WFRC Chief Financial Officer, to review the FY24 WFRC Budget amendments. Andrew Gruber, WFRC Executive Director, acknowledged that WFRC staff is available to answer questions and be transparent

He stated that three major biking and walking projects had recent ribbon cutting events, and reiterated the importance of attending the transportation workshops to learn more about and give input on the Utah Trail Network.
- **b. Executive Director's update [01:48:16]** Andrew Gruber, WFRC, recognized Hugh Van Wagenen for five years of employment with WFRC.

9. Other Business and Adjournment [01:50:05]

Mayor Ramsey noted the upcoming events on the agenda. The next meeting of the WFRC Council will be held on January 25, 2024. Mayor Ramsey also noted that the plan for Council meetings in 2024 is to change the start time from 2:00pm to 1:30pm. This would better align with the FrontRunner schedule and make it more feasible for people to use - the station is just a few hundred yards away. This would also enable people who drive to leave earlier, and better avoid traffic. [01:52:16] Mayor Mike Caldwell made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Mayor Mark Shepherd. The motion was approved unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 3:59pm.

The scope of the I-84; Over Weber River and UPRR Bridge project will replace two bridges, 2C 476 and 4C 476, on I-84 over the Weber River at milepost 91 in Weber County. Based on the most recent estimate, the total project value of this project has increased by \$16,000,000 since the project design was initiated in 2020. The complicated geometry in the canyon and the relationship of the road to the railroad, has led to additional walls, rockfall mitigation, and other modifications to the originally proposed alignment. The S-Line, which launched in 2013, currently runs between Central Pointe Station (221 W. 2100 South in South Salt Lake) to Fairmont Station, which is located at 1040 E. 2200 South in Salt Lake City. UTA completed some double-tracking on the line in 2019 that allowed the street car service to run every 15 minutes. This project will extend the S-Line from the end of line at Fairmont Station at 1040 East along the north side of Simpson Avenue to the heart of the Sugar House business district at Highland Drive. This is a distance of about 900 feet. The projected cost for this extension is \$16 million for construction related costs (including right of way, utilities, etc.) and \$7 million for a vehicle for a total of \$23 million. The Utah Legislature has appropriated \$12 Million for the project. Salt Lake City is pursuing \$10 million from sources such as Transit Transportation Investment Fund (TTIF). Utah Transit Authority has funding allocated to cover amounts that TTIF may not be able to, and to cover cost escalations/contingencies.

downtown Salt Lake City

At the January 18th Regional Growth Committee (RGC) meeting, WFRC staff, and representatives from Salt Lake City, presented a certification request for 13 Salt Lake City station areas, in accordance with the Station Area Planning (SAP) components of state law and WFRC policy: 900 South, 600 South, Courthouse, Gallivan Plaza, City Center, Temple Square, Arena, Planetarium, Old Greek Town, Salt Lake Central TRAX, Salt Lake Central FrontRunner, North Temple Bridge/Guadeloupe TRAX, and North Temple FrontRunner.

RGC recommended that the Wasatch Front Regional Council certify these 13 stations, as they meet the requirements for prior actions as described below.

BACKGROUND:

<u>HB462</u>, passed in 2022, as amended in 2023, requires cities with fixed-guideway transit stations to develop a Station Area Plan for the area around the station, within ½ mile for rail and ¼ mile of bus rapid transit. <u>Station Area Plans</u> (SAPs) are intended to promote housing availability and affordability, access to opportunities, sustainable environmental conditions, and transportation choices and connections. The <u>SAP requirements</u> are consistent with communities' identification of <u>Wasatch Choice Vision</u> centers.

WFRC staff has been assisting communities in their development of their station area plans, in partnership with UTA, GOEO, and the Mountainland Association of Governments (MAG). At the RGC meeting, WFRC staff will provide an update on Station Area Planning to date, and discuss the Salt Lake City SAPs that have been submitted to WFRC for certification, pursuant to state law and WFRC policy.

STATION AREA PLAN CERTIFICATION

State law establishes that the Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs – WFRC and MAG) have the responsibility to review and, in consultation with UTA, certify each SAP for compliance with statutory requirements. In May of 2022, and amended in March of 2023, WFRC adopted a policy for the certification review of SAPs.

Cities may satisfy the SAP requirements, in whole or in part, by submitting adopted resolutions that find that prior actions have substantially promoted the SAP objectives in whole or in part. Prior actions refer to adopted plans or ordinances, approved land use applications, approved agreements or financing, or investments that have been made, before June 1, 2022, that substantially promote each of the four objectives within the station area. Cities must demonstrate that such plans, ordinances, approved land use applications, approved agreements or financing, or investments are still relevant to making meaningful progress towards achieving such objectives.

ACTION: Certify Salt Lake City Downtown Stations

Salt Lake City has submitted an adopted resolution finding that prior actions substantially promote the required objectives for the city's downtown station areas, pursuant to 10-9a-403.1 (2)(b). Such prior actions include but are not limited to: the Downtown Plan; zoning changes that allow up to, and even exceed, 50 units/acre, and encourage a mix of uses; cycling

improvements such as those along 300 West and 900 S; reduced or eliminated parking minimums; water-wise landscaping requirements; improvements to Pioneer Park; and the Funding Our Future sales tax increase to fund affordable housing initiatives. The Downtown Plan included a goal to build 10,000 homes downtown by 2040. As of 2022, the city had already built 9,076, with hundreds more on the way. The extensive list of actions taken by Salt Lake City to fulfill the requirements pursuant to 10-9a-403.1 (2)(b) is summarized in the Staff Findings attachment. Though there is a high degree of overlap amongst the 13 station areas, the report organizes the actions by each station area, as well as by the four objectives outlined in the legislation.

In accordance with our policy, WFRC staff has reviewed the submission to assess its satisfaction of the requirements of the statute, and made a <u>positive recommendation for certification</u> to the Regional Growth Committee. All of the documentation is included within, including:

- 1. Salt Lake City's Downtown Stations Resolution
- 2. WFRC SAP Certification Resolution
- 3. WFRC Staff Findings and Analysis

RGC voted to recommend the Council certify these stations based on the analysis of the SLC submission.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

The Regional Growth Committee and WFRC staff recommend that the Council adopt a "motion to certify these 13 downtown Salt Lake City Station Areas."

SUBJECT: Potential Impacts of Federal Ozone Air Quality Standards

PREPARED BY: Wayne Bennion, Director of Short Range Planning

Utah is currently not able to meet requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act related to ozone levels. These requirements are extremely difficult to meet because of high levels of "background" ozone, which comes from outside Utah or from natural sources. This situation poses potential risks for significant highway and transit capacity-increasing projects to proceed. WFRC staff, in collaboration with Utah Division of Air Quality staff, will brief the Regional Council on this issue and discuss ongoing collaborative efforts to address the situation.

BACKGROUND:

When national air quality standards are established, the federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) designates areas throughout the country as attaining or not attaining these standards. In 2018, the EPA designated the "northern Wasatch Front" area as nonattainment for ozone. Since that time, the Utah State Division of Air Quality (DAQ) has been monitoring ozone levels, modeling air quality conditions, and developing what is known as a State Implementation Plan (SIP) for air quality. The purpose of a SIP is to describe how the air quality standard will be attained. WFRC, UDOT, and others have provided technical and other support in this process.

As a Metropolitan Planning Organization, under federal law WFRC has the responsibility to determine the conformity of transportation plans and programs in our region with the applicable emission budgets established in the SIP.

If the EPA disapproves the ozone SIP adopted by the Air Quality Board, that will trigger regulatory restrictions that can have significant consequences on Utah's transportation and development, restrictions that can become increasingly onerous over time.

Recognizing the deleterious impacts on human health from ozone, Utah is making concerted efforts to reduce the emissions that lead to the formation of ozone.

But the particular challenge faced in Utah -- a challenge that is shared across the intermountain west -- is that the majority of our ozone is "background" ozone; it comes from outside of Utah (from other states or even internationally), and/or from natural sources (e.g., certain trees). Therefore, even with careful management and control of emissions, ozone levels still exceed the applicable standards.






Local versus uncontrollable emissions

Summer ozone formation is driven by precursor emissions from local, transported and natural sources.

Only 14% of the emissions that dive ozone concentrations along the Wasatch Front are from Utah manmade sources.

What can be regulated by the state is about 5.8% of the total.

Most reasonable controls have already been implemented for winter PM2.5 particulate planning efforts



Strategy to Address Transportation Impacts

- Work to meet requirements with the State Implementation Planning tools that reduce emissions and show reasonable progress.
- Prepare a modeling demonstration of the impact of international transported emissions under CAA 179B.
- Litigation strategy based on EPA actions under international transport and plan reviews.
- Multistate letter/congressional actions to amend the prescriptive provisions of the Clean Air Act and EPA's implementing regulations.

Federal Clean Air Standards: Impacts of Nonattainment on Transportation Funding and Planning

- DEQ needs support for emission reduction rules and incentive programs to attempt to meet CAA requirements.
 - Rule R307-314 Limitations on Use of Two-Stroke Small Off-Road Engines in Yard
 Care Activities
 - Reallocate Incentive funding to purchase electric two-stroke equipment
 - FTE for State Implementation Plan Coordinator
 - Support funding plan for international transport modeling
- UDOT is working with transportation partners to ensure that transportation plans are updated before a potential freeze.
