#### **Welcome and Introductions**

Andrew Gruber, Wasatch Front Regional Council (WFRC), opened the meeting at 11:33am, by welcoming the attendees. **[00:01:40]** Mr. Gruber noted that, as in the past, the facilitation of the JPAC meetings rotates between Utah Transit Authority (UTA), Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT), Mountainland Association of Governments (MAG), and Wasatch Front Regional Council (WFRC). WFRC will facilitate the meetings for 2022. **[00:13:30]** Roundtable introductions were made by members of the committee.

#### 1. Approval of April 1 2021 Meeting Minutes [00:04:19]

Mr. Gruber requested a motion to approve the minutes from the JPAC meeting held on April 1, 2021. UTA Board Trustee Carlton Christensen made a motion to accept the meeting minutes as written. Carlos Braceras, UDOT, seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Andrew Gruber, WFRC, discussed the tentative schedule for the meetings in 2022, and stated that meetings/site visits could be held in different locations, to address transportation issues in all areas represented by this group.
