6 Information: RPO LRP [00:00:06]

a. Timeline, tasks, public input, future workshops - The main role of the RPO is to work on the County project list and plan. The next meeting will go over the city and county active transportation master plans, the Utah Trail Network, review land use, review evaluation criteria, update the Wasatch Choice Vision Map and the centers on the map, and lastly, to review performance measures. As a group we will be going over these items to ensure everything is correct and to update any items that need it. As an AOG, WFRC is working on population counts, the county and city will get updated population numbers. The WFRC LRTP is going to change from 2027-2050 to 2027-2055. In August of 2025 the RPO group will review project level criteria , review the draft preferred scenario and exploratory projects, and get public input. In October of 2025 the RPO will review a draft phased plan which will be needs based only, review project level performance measures, possibly get public input, the RPO will finish the plan and present it to each city and county commission and adopt it by resolution, and incorporate the plan into the UDOT Rural LRP. State projects need to be incorporated into the UDOT Rural LRP for funding. UDOT and the Morgan RPO will work together to figure out which projects need to be in phase 1 and are a priority to ensure the projects are eligible for funding.
