**1. Introductions and Consent Agenda [00:00:48]**

At 9:48am, Regional Growth Committee Chair, Mayor Robert Dandoy, welcomed the members and guests of the Regional Growth Committee Meeting. Introductions were made around the table and online via roll call.

**ACTION [00:04:10]:** Utah Transportation Commissioner Kevin Van Tassell made a motion to approve the [Minutes](#) of the RGC Meeting held August 17, 2023. North Salt Lake Mayor Brian Horrocks seconded the motion, there was no discussion, minutes were approved unanimously.

**3. Chair Report [00:05:07]**

Mayor Dandoy introduced Jory Johner, WFRC Long Range Planning Manager, who gave an introduction on the updated Unified Transportation Plan, and the features of the new website, including the interactive map.

**4. Information: Implementing the [Wasatch Choice Vision](#) [00:31:57]**

Mayor Dandoy introduced Ted Knowlton, WFRC Deputy Director, who gave an overview of the Wasatch Choice Vision which is a shared framework for coordinating near and long term transportation, land use and economic development activities. Hugh Van Wagenen, WFRC gave an update on the upcoming Fall Workshops, which will be held in five areas throughout the region in November and will take a more area-specific approach to the Wasatch Choice Vision implementation. Marcia White, WFRC and Eric Gibson, Better City, gave an update on the Economic Development portion of the Vision. Ted Knowlton, WFRC led a discussion among members focusing on issues that relate to the Vision, as well as potential actions to help address those issues.

**5. Information: Parking Policy Modernization Guide [01:25:18]**

Mayor Dandoy asked Julie Bjornstad, WFRC, to give an overview of the Parking Policy Modernization Guide which helps address the concerns around parking. Ms. Bjornstad discussed how the parking dynamics have drastically changed over the years, while the policy manual remains the same. WFRC's Modernization Guide helps to bridge the gap between policy and demand. She also mentioned some other resources available to planners within WFRC.

Mayor Dandoy explained that this Station Area Plan Certification request would be tabled until the January meeting.
