Wasatch Choice Fall Transportation Workshops / Draft Phased 2023-2050 RTP Jory Johner, WFRC Long Range Planning Group Manager	<p>Jory Johner, WFRC Manager of the Long-Range Planning Group, gave an overview of the Wasatch Choice Vision and the Regional Transportation Plan. He reminded everyone that the draft Fiscally Constrained phasing of the regional plan will be discussed at the fall Wasatch Choice Transportation Workshops and have been reviewed by many in the room, and that the workshops will invite the local communities – including planning commissioners, other city staff, city councils, and mayors across the region to get their feedback. The map shared for the workshops across the region will be the Draft 2023 RTP Workshops Map. The Wasatch Choice Transportation Workshops will specifically be looking for feedback on the financially constrained phasing.
