CMAQ Project Adjustment	Tyler Laing, UDOT ITS Program Manager, reviewed potential funding availability for installation of a variable message sign in Tooele Valley and asked the RPO if they would be ok with UDOT using \$110,000 from a signal project that had previously been programmed with Tooele Valley CMAQ funds, and had been completed.
