1. Approve December 9 , 2019 Minutes (0:30)

Mayor Brent Marshall, Motion Commissioner Kendall Thomas, 2nd **Approved.**

2. Transit Study and Area Corridor Study Updates (1:30)

Grant Farnsworth of UDOT reported that the kick-off meeting for the Area Corridor Study will be held soon. Data collection has been occurring to help inform the Study.

Levi Roberts of UTA said that the next steering committee meeting for the Transit Feasibility Study will be held on March 18. The focus will be to review open house results and existing conditions.

3. Tooele Valley CMAQ Application Review (10:28)

Lisa Zundel reviewed the three applications that had been received for Tooele Valley Congestion Mitigation Air Quality funding. Mayor Brent Marshall and James Waltz of Grantsville discussed the need for, and details associated with, the three projects. Elden Bingham of UDOT noted that FHWA determines the eligibility of projects and Wayne Bennion of WFRC distributed a handout (attached) identifying the federal funds, local match, and air quality benefit for each of the projects. There is approximately \$870,000 currently available in Tooele Valley CMAQ funds. Mayor Winn made a motion (33:40) that the RPO recommend that UDOT provide CMAQ funds for the two sidewalk projects, James Waltz seconded the motion, and the RPO voted to approve the motion. Mayor Marshall made a motion that at the next meeting, the RPO receive information about whether the proposed property along SR-138 could be used for a park and ride lot. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion and the RPO voted to approve the motion.

4. Midvalley Highway Update (45:00)

Oanh Le-Spradlin of UDOT reported that surcharge material will continue to be hauled through the first week of June, after which the material will be allowed to settle for several months. The I-80 westbound auxiliary lane project is out to bid and construction is anticipated to start this summer.

5. I-80 Bridge Replacements Update (53:51)

Pat Kalisz of Granite Construction reported on the status of this UDOT project. Detailed finishing work is expected over the next few months on the SR-36 bridge. For the Black Rock bridges, traffic is anticipated to be switched to the new westbound bridge in early summer, while the eastbound bridge is replaced.

6. Legislative Update (55:32)

Wayne distributed a summary of Senate Bill 150 regarding transportation governance and funding amendments. He will make sure that those who have not been receiving WFRC's legislative updates and bill tracker are added to the distribution list.

7. Other Business (59:37)

The deadline for applications for the Utah Outdoor Recreation Grants is March 20.
