1. December 12, 2022 Meeting Minutes

Motion - Mayor Debbie Winn, Tooele City Second - Councilmember Scott Droubay, Erda APPROVED

2. Draft Statewide Long Range Transportation Plan: 2023-2050

Jay Aguilar, UDOT Long Range Planning Manager, reported on the Utah Statewide Rural Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRP) noting that it is updated every 4 years and includes all transportation modes. The LRP covers the areas of the state that are outside of the Census-defined large urban areas and projects in the Rural LRTP are fiscally constrained based on forecast revenues (see table below). 3. Midvalley Highway Update

Oanh Le-Spradlin, UDOT Project Manager, reported that the environmental assessment for phases 2 and 3 of the Midvalley Highway has been delayed by the need to have an element of the project be included in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). UDOT is working on determining if corridor preservation can count as that element. Discussion occurred regarding the need to have the alignment for Phase 3 identified and shared, and the need for the project to move forward.

Becky Stromness, UDOT Project Manager, reported on 2 projects on SR-36. The extension of the southbound third lane to Stansbury Park is anticipated to start construction in Summer 2024. The third lane project from Stansbury Park northbound to I-80 with an auxiliary lane on eastbound I-80 to the SR-201 exit is scheduled to start construction in 2025. Construction of the final alignment will be within the available ROW. Legislative funding made it possible to accelerate this project from the initial 2028 schedule.

4. Draft 2050 Tooele Valley Transit Element

Clint Campbell of UTA discussed the success of the Tooele Valley on-demand service and shared suggestions for plans to address transit needs, including but not limited to the following.

Near Term - implementation of the next phase of on-demand service.

Intermediate Term - improve access for students, pedestrians, and bicyclists.

Long Term - increase service, preserve future service options, implement all-day regional express service to Salt Lake City.

UTA electrification of on-demand service in Tooele will be 100% electric by Fall 2023 which consists of 10 electric vans, 2 UTA garage-based charging stations, and 2 on-route charging stations.

5. Next Steps - Tooele Valley Long Range Transportation Plan

Wayne Bennion is compiling information received about the Tooele Valley LRP. The draft is scheduled to be presented in September 2023. The Tooele Valley LRP is not financially constrained.

6. Other Business

Kip Billings reported on progress with the Safe Streets for All (SS4A) Comprehensive Action Plan. A consultant has been selected and will begin the study shortly with a targeted completion date of June 2024. The Action Plan development will include Geographic Focus Areas, including one for Tooele County to explore more specific needs and local stakeholder feedback in the six-county study area.

There will be an opportunity to nominate projects for the Active Transportation and First/Last Mile components of the Transportation Investment Fund. More information to follow.

An online survey for "Guiding Our Growth" is available. Input is welcome and is being collected statewide.

A notice of funding opportunity (NOFO) for multimodal projects within the FHWA discretionary grant programs will be coming soon. The details of the "RSTP" grant program for rural areas will be provided.
