

UTA Rideshare has a staff of 11 people. The Weber/Davis program reduced VMT by 3.7M last year. High fuel prices are attracting more users.

4. Information Item – ATMS Annual Report - Tyler Laing

Technology issues forced cancellation of this item.

5. Information Item – GreenBike Annual Report - Ben Bolte

Users can make unlimited rides for an annual fee of \$75.00. New Executive Director is Stan Penfold. GreenBike launched at Ogden in August with six stations and a total of 60 bicycles Ogden and Salt Lake services will be expanding, and adding e-bikes.

6. City Project Report/ Information – Karen Baxter, North Salt Lake

A new general plan was adopted in 2013 including roads and active transportation. Challenges include limited transit, railroad crossings, and access to I-15. Proposal to close Main St./US-89 intersection as part of a Town Center Plan. East and west residential areas of NSL are divided by a large commercial/industrial area, railroads, and freeway. Center Street and 1100 North (becomes 2600 South) are the only freeway/railroad crossings. This situation creates emergency vehicle access issues and congestion issues, particularly when trains block the at-grade crossings at Center Street or 1100 North. Proposal for grade separation for 1100 North. Also need I-15/I-215 connections.
