
- 1. **Action Item** *February 28th Meeting Minutes* Brooke Stewart
 - a. Motion Chad Boshell, Farmington

- 2. **Information**: County Funding Programs
 - a. **Davis County**Jeff Oyler
 Jeff explained how the 3rd Quarter local option 0.25% sales tax is being used for transportation projects in Davis County. Letters of intent for projects are due May 3rd, followed by applications which will be due in July.. The COG reviews potential projects and makes award approvals in October. There is about \$13-15M available each year.
 - b. Weber County

 Brooke Stewart

 Brooke noted that details about the Weber County 3rd Quarter local option sales tax can be found at WeberCountyUtah.gov. The 3rd Quarter option started in 2007, and includes corridor preservation. Letters of intent were previously due in June, but this has been moved up to May 6. Applications are due July 8. County approval is determined before the end of the year. There is \$14.6M available this year.
- 3. Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Business Ben Wuthrich
 - a. **Information**: Review Schedule for the 2025-2030 TIP Process Ben reviewed the TIP schedule as shown below. Field reviews, comments, and staff evaluations are completed.



The number of projects proposed, amount requested, and amount available for each of the four funding programs is illustrated below.



b. Action: Review and Recommend STP Projects

Ben reviewed each STP project that was proposed and provided this <u>list of proposed STP projects</u>. WFRC staff recommended partial funding for projects

#1 - \$2.0M - 40th St; Riverdale Road to Washington Blvd (South Ogden)

#2 - \$2.0M - Parkin Overpass Replacement; 500 West & US-89 (Main Str) (Bountiful)

#4 - \$1.0M - 1300 North & 1500 West (Clinton)

#5 - \$1.5M - SR-106 (Main Str); Park Lane to Shepard Lane (Farmington)

#6 - \$1.5M - 700 South; 4000 West to 4500 West (West Point)

#8 - \$1.0M - Main Street; 350 North to Pacific Avenue (North Salt Lake)

#18 - \$1.5M - 750 West; West Harrisville Rd to US-89 (Harrisville City)

There was a motion to reduce funds for #18 by \$862K in order to fund project #3 in Centerville. During discussion it was observed that this motion would tilt the funding to about \$7.0M for Davis County and \$3.0M for Weber. The motion did not carry.

A second motion to accept the staff recommendation was made.
