- 2. Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Business Ben Wuthrich
 - a. Information Item New Projects for the Draft 2023-2028 TIP for Public Review TIP projects recommended by TAC will be presented at the WFRC Council meeting tomorrow for approval. The Salt Lake TAC considered 58 projects totaling \$537M in requests for STP, CMAQ, and TAP funds. The TAC recommended 11 STP projects for \$31.4M, 5 CMAQ projects for \$6.3M, and 9 TAP projects for \$3.8M.

- 4. **Midvale City Presentation** **Keith Ludwig** Keith was unable to join today.

There are three projects from the TIP in progress in Murray.

- 1. Vine Street Phase II (1300 East to Van Winkle)
 - Adding bike lanes and sidewalk and rehabilitating pavement and utilities. Eliminated on-street parking and park strips. Original estimate was \$5M, final cost was \$7M due to increased construction and material costs. Murray City absorbed most of the cost overrun.
- 2. 5300 South & College Drive Intersection Improvements
 - Funded with CMAQ, adding double left turn lanes to reduce delay. Pedestrian safety was also improved. Commercial property owners are delaying ROW acquisition.
- 3. Winchester & 700 West

Due to the length of the meeting and the limited time, Trae did not get to review the Winchester & 700 West project but for information, it is an Intersection and Pedestrian Improvement project for which the City will be beginning the environmental process with the hopes to begin design near the end of the year.
