1. **Action Item – [March 30th Meeting Minutes](#)Becca Roof**

2. **Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Business Ben Wuthrich**
 - a. **Information Item – New Projects for the Draft 2023-2028 TIP for Public Review**
TIP projects recommended by TAC will be presented at the WFRC Council meeting tomorrow for approval. The Salt Lake TAC considered 58 projects totaling \$537M in requests for STP, CMAQ, and TAP funds. The TAC recommended 11 STP projects for \$31.4M, 5 CMAQ projects for \$6.3M, and 9 TAP projects for \$3.8M.

 - b. **Information Item – Review Schedule for the 2023-2028 TIP Process**
The Regional Council is scheduled to approve the draft projects in their meeting on Thursday, May 26th. In June, Trans Com will have the opportunity to review the draft documents and recommend that the draft 2023-2028 TIP and the draft 2023-2028 corresponding Air Quality Conformity finding go out for the public review and comment, with the comment period beginning on June 25th and going through July 30th. WFRC staff will then present to the TAC in their July meeting a summary of comments received to date and other information received. During their August meetings both Trans Com and the Regional Council are scheduled to review, recommend, and approve the 2023-2028 TIP and Air Quality Conformity finding respectively. Also in the August meeting, the next TIP process will initiate and the request for letters of intent will be sent out with a due date near the end of September.

3. **Salt Lake County - Transportation Funds Helen Peters**
Local sales tax option for 4th Quarter (0.10%) is available to cities in Salt Lake County. There is also a Salt Lake County Corridor Preservation fund that has about \$1M. To maximize these resources, Salt Lake County waits for the fund balance to rise to \$3M before they solicit for applications.
Salt Lake County receives 0.05% of the 4th quarter sales tax.

4. **Midvale City Presentation Keith Ludwig**
Keith was unable to join today.

5. **Murray City Presentation..... Trae Stokes**

There are three projects from the TIP in progress in Murray.

1. Vine Street – Phase II (1300 East to Van Winkle)
Adding bike lanes and sidewalk and rehabilitating pavement and utilities. Eliminated on-street parking and park strips. Original estimate was \$5M, final cost was \$7M due to increased construction and material costs. Murray City absorbed most of the cost overrun.
2. 5300 South & College Drive Intersection Improvements
Funded with CMAQ, adding double left turn lanes to reduce delay. Pedestrian safety was also improved. Commercial property owners are delaying ROW acquisition.
3. Winchester & 700 West
Due to the length of the meeting and the limited time, Trae did not get to review the Winchester & 700 West project but for information, it is an Intersection and Pedestrian Improvement project for which the City will be beginning the environmental process with the hopes to begin design near the end of the year.

6. UDOT Region Two Workshop Report Brad Palmer

UDOT Region 2 has about 50 projects lined up for construction for the next 2 years:

2022

- 15 paving projects
- I-15 Overhead Signs
- SR-68 from 6200 S to I-215
- I-80 Variable speed sign upgrade
- SR-266 (4500 S) at Atwood Blvd.
- I-15 NB yield condition at 5300 S
- Highland Dr. pin and hanger replacement

2023

- 6 paving projects
- SR-154 (Bangerter Hwy.) Concrete barrier
- SR-85 (Mt. View) intersection safety improvements
- Wrong-way Driver mitigation (pavement markings)
- I-15 Overhead Signs – improved reflectivity
- I-80 rockfall barrier
- SR-210 avalanche mitigation (replace Howitzer)
- Foothill Blvd. pedestrian solutions – test concept
- I-15 concrete repairs
- SR-175 (11400 S) concrete rehabilitation
- 1-80 culvert rehabilitation
- Region 2 CCTV
- I-80 entrance bridge near airport
- I-15 spaghetti bowl – paint structures
- ...and other rehabilitation and safety upgrades

- I-80 & I-215 – lanes restored in 2023
- 9000 S: Redwood to 700 West
- Bangerter Hwy – four interchanges

Cost estimates are being revised prior to soliciting bids due to rapid increase in costs. Some projects are being postponed until costs stabilize. Asphalt is up 50% and ROW 15%.

- 7. Safe Streets for All (SS4A) – Grant Program Kip Billings**
Kip explained this new funding program aimed at reducing fatalities and serious injuries on city and county roadways as part of the IIJA transportation bill. WFRC is pursuing a grant for a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan for the Weber, Davis, Salt Lake, Morgan, Tooele, and southern Box Elder County area. The slides presented can be found [here](#).
