2. *Information* – 2023 Legislative Heads-up - Miranda Jones Cox

The 45-day legislative session began yesterday. During the first few weeks, legislators typically address budgets and appropriations. WFRC has a bill tracker for transportation-related legislation (see below). Big issues are water, education, housing, and taxes.

Funding for a Utah statewide trail network has been proposed. Additional funding for transit solutions for the Point of the Mountain is also being considered, along with double track for Front Runner operations. A one-year free fare transit test case is also being proposed. An effort to pay down highway transportation capacity project debt has been introduced.


There are now four funding programs: CMAQ, STP, TAP, and the new Carbon Reduction Program (CRP).
