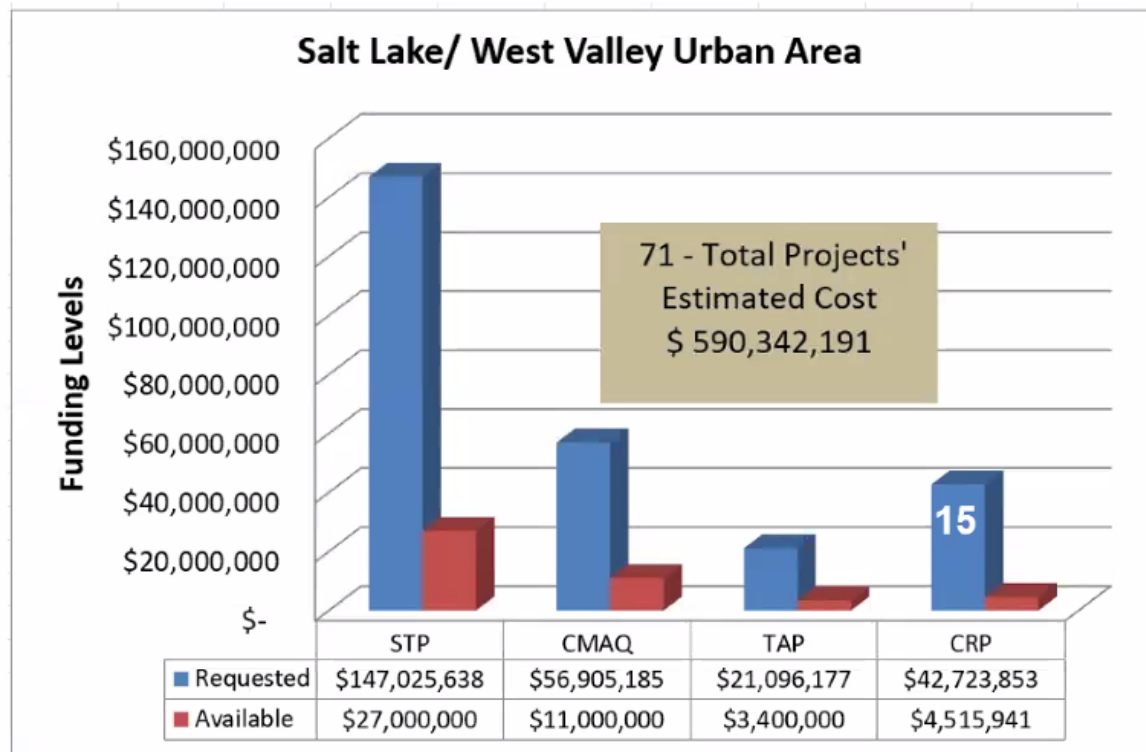
o **Information** – TAC Projects Preview

Field reviews will be March 8-9 for the Salt Lake/West Valley area. Virtual attendance will be possible. A small group will travel to each project site and share the audio and video of the on-site discussion. There is a zoom link in the Field Review calendar appointment.

The graph below displays that the requested funds exceed available funds for all programs.

The increased amount of CMAQ funds to program this year is a result of moving CMAQ projects that are eligible for the Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) into the first two years of the CRP program to facilitate obligation of these funds and avoid any CRP funding loss.



- **STP – 31 Projects**
- **CMAQ - 15 Projects**
- **TAP – 10 Projects**
- **CRP – 15 Projects**

The scope of the Millcreek 2000 East shown on the slide will be corrected. For this year, Phase 2 of 2000 East was submitted which is from 3300 South north to the city line – which would be about half the length and cost of what was displayed.

The cost of the West Valley City/Taylorsville 3900 South project will also be corrected.

2. City Project Report/ Information - Taylorsville

In an effort to improve the functionality of, and the safety for young children at a school bus-stop, Taylorsville City, UDOT, and the local neighborhood worked together to construct a pedestrian walkway from an isolated neighborhood to a safe central location for both the waiting students and standing bus. This was a

significant accomplishment where there was no single party responsible for the needed improvements.
