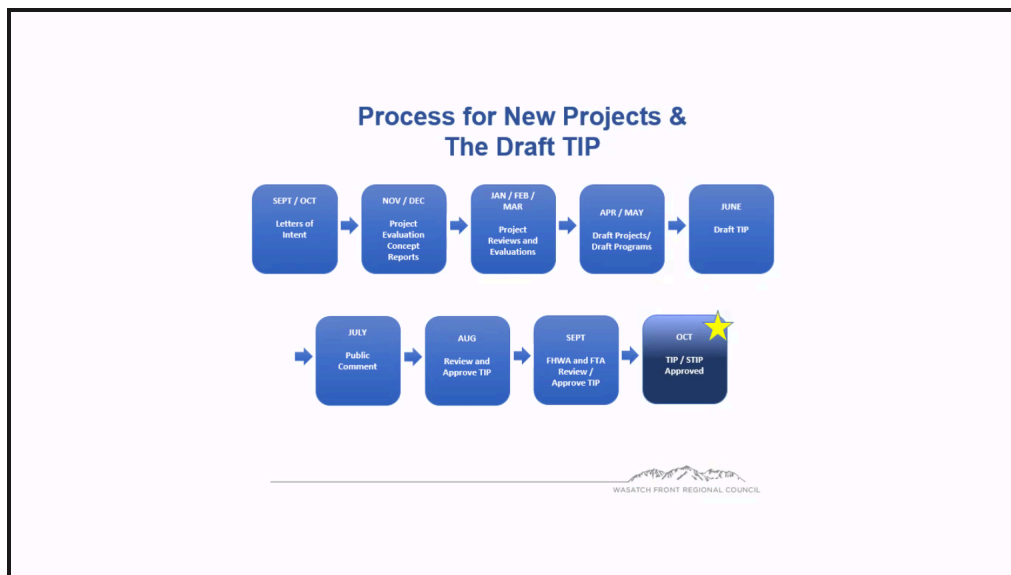

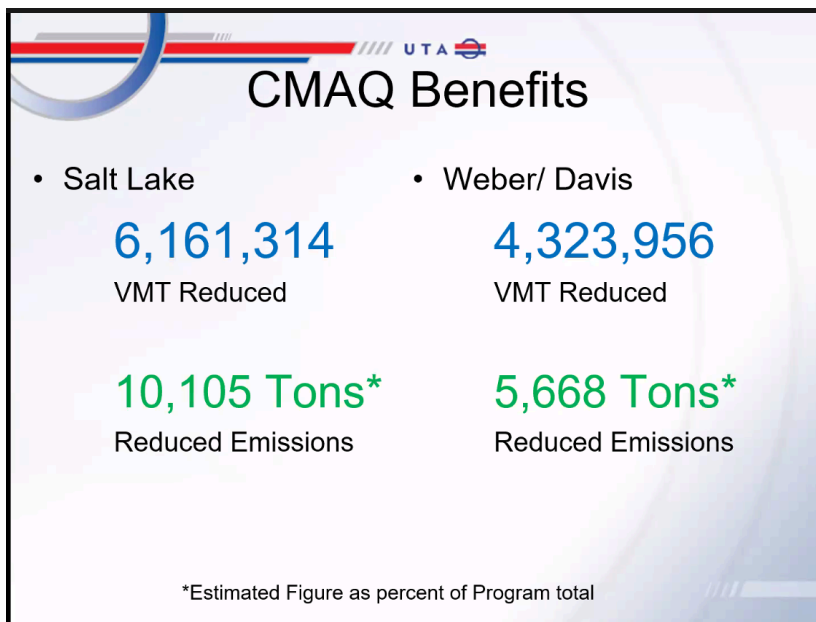
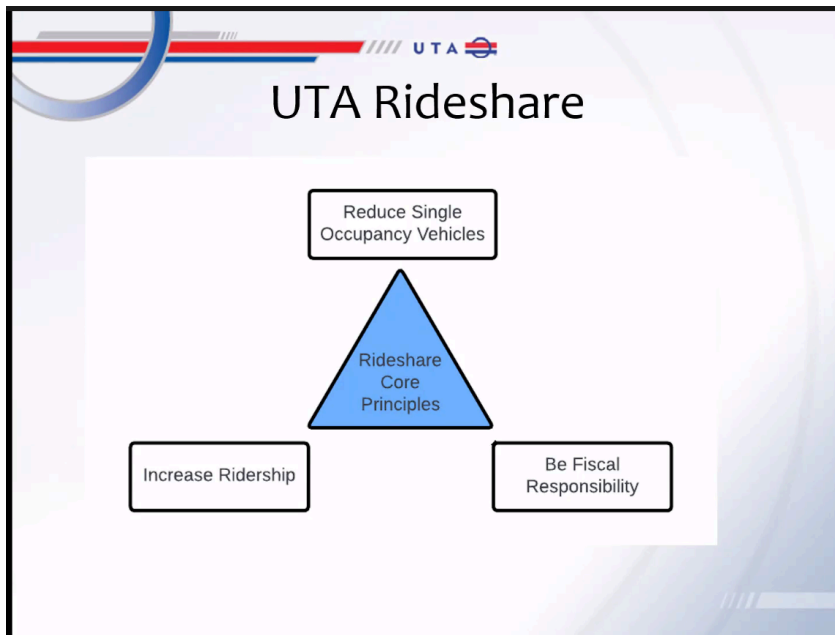

*There are 1700 cameras in the system which are being upgraded to digital cameras with much better resolution. About 85% of cameras are now digital.*

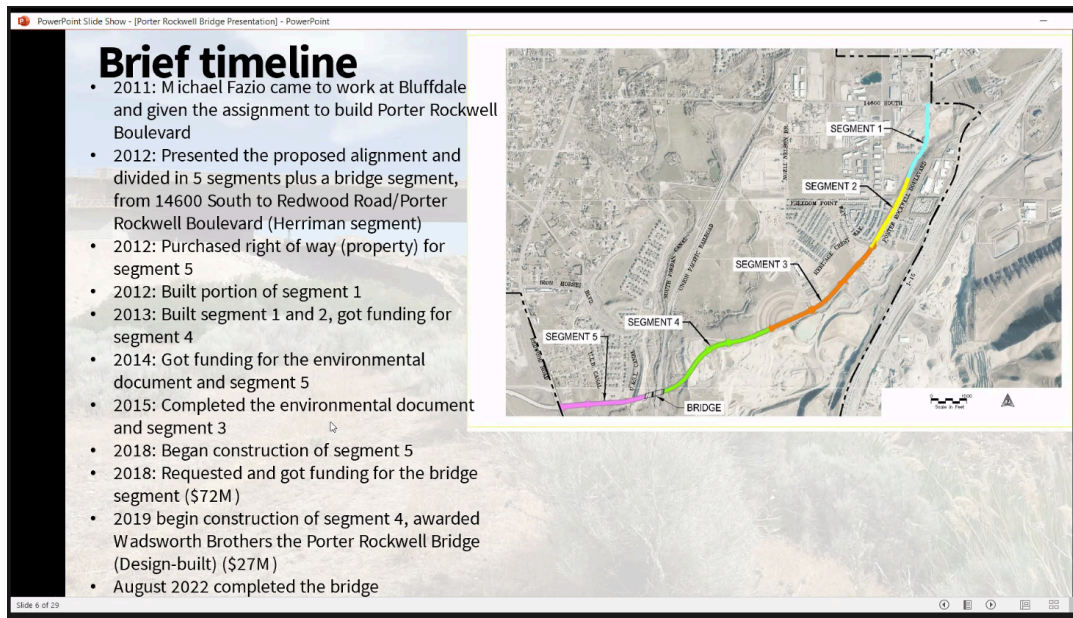
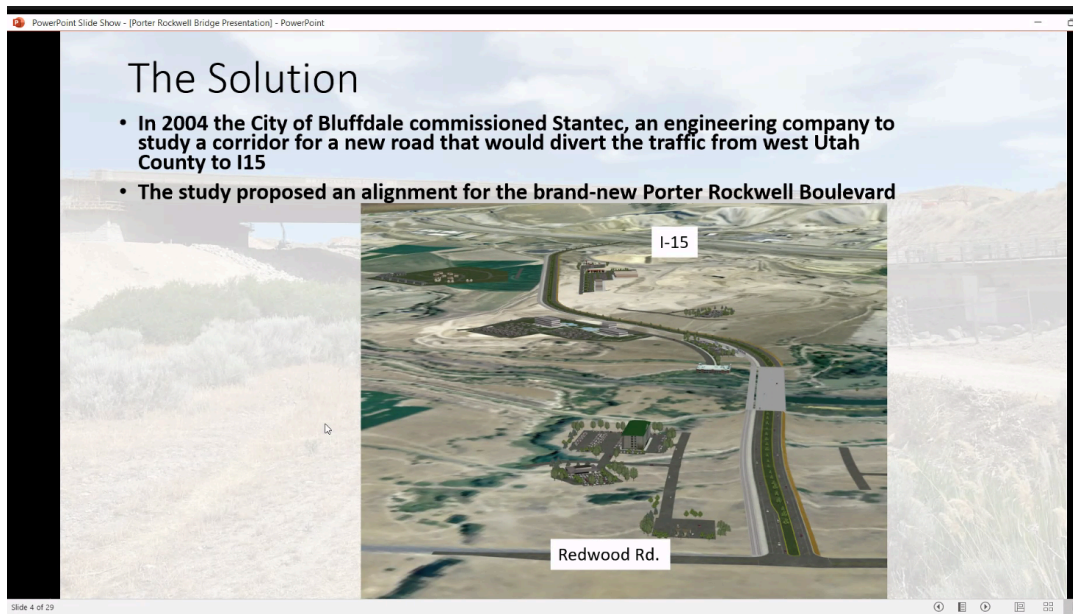
*Region 2 is adding about 5 new signals annually all with communication capabilities to TOC. TOC software built in 1998 is using the original software. SWRI is upgrading the TOC system to Active ITS by the end of 2023. Video monitoring and traffic management is greatly enhanced. Ben suggested a tour of the TOC for members of the TAC.*
