2. **Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Business - Ben Wuthrich**

- a. Board Modification - WVC transit hub project at 3650 South (Lancer Way) was originally estimated at \$8.0M. It is now estimated to cost an additional \$3.0M. WVC has secured \$1.7M and is requesting an additional \$1.25M from Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds to complete the project.

2. **B&C Roads Discussion - Chris Potter**

B&C road funds help with construction and maintenance of city and county roads. State gas tax revenues are divided between local governments and UDOT, with 30% going to local governments (B&C class roads) and 70% going to UDOT for state roads. In 1998, the responsibility of measuring and reporting lane miles for each city and unincorporated county was shifted from the State to the individual cities and counties.

B&C funds are distributed every two months using a formula that is 50% population and 50% road miles. Paved, gravel, and dirt roads are weighted 5, 2, and 2 respectively. In lieu of gas tax, EV's are assessed a per/mile user fee or a flat fee at the time of registration.

3. **UTA TDM Annual Report - Michael Goldman**

UTA maintains a staff of 11 people for the Rideshare program. About 50% of Rideshare expenses are covered by CMAQ funds. Rideshare has 106 vanpools in the Weber/Davis area and 207 in the Salt Lake area. UTA has not requested CMAQ assistance for a number of years, but UTA will be requesting funds for expansion this year.

**4. ITS Annual Report - Matt Luker**

UDOT now has 5,791 state and local traffic signals that are connected to the Traffic Operations Center. This is a 27% increase since 2019. CCTV cameras are being upgraded to digital.

Future ITS projects include the I-15 project from SLC to Farmington. New CCTV cameras will be deployed on Bangerter Highway and Mountain View Corridor.

**5. Green Bike Annual Report – Cameron Ariano**

Green Bike started in SLC 12 years ago and expanded to the Ogden area in 2022. Bike use in 2024 increased by 50% over 2023. E-bikes are proving to be especially popular. Plans are to expand in 2025 by 5-10 stations, particularly those adjacent to transit stations and bike trails. Expanding to college campuses in Salt Lake City and Ogden is a priority for the future.

**6. Holladay City Presentation - Jared Bunch**

Holladay is mostly a residential community with 35,000 residents. City revenue relies on sales tax, but by 2008 the Cottonwood Mall was closed which put serious constraints on city budgets. Property taxes and stormwater fees were increased to provide revenues for needed infrastructure maintenance. In 2024 the City was able to bond for \$18M for needed storm drain and bridge projects.
