1. **Action Item – October 16, 2024 Meeting Minutes - Matt Shipp**

2. **UDOT Project Report - Kendall Draney**

Kendall reported on the 2025 construction plans for UDOT. Capacity increasing projects will be in progress at 5 locations including Bangerter Hwy. interchanges, I-80 and SR-36 in Tooele County, SR-111, SR-209 (9000 South), and I-215. Several pavement preservation projects will also be undertaken, and a number of safety projects including lighting, signal upgrades, barriers, and sidewalks.

3. **Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Business - Ben Wuthrich**

- **Action** – Modification for the 2025-2030 TIP

1. **PIN 15914 – South Jordan – Riverfront Parkway; 11050 South to 11400 South –Widen from 3 to 5 lanes including curb, gutter, sidewalk, park strip, intersection improvements, and necessary streetlights.**

The original project was to widen from 3 to 5 lanes for an estimated \$1.8M. Due to ROW acquisition, intersection upgrades at 11400 South, and inflation, the new estimated cost is \$4.8M. South Jordan has secured \$1.6M in additional funds and is requesting from WFRC the additional \$1.4M in STP funds to complete the project.

2. **PIN 7650 – UTA - 5600 West Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Phase I; 2700 South to 6200 South - ROW & Construction of Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)**

The request supports the efforts of the 5600 W project to adjust where sources of funding will be most effectively used. The request is to use the CMAQ funds to expand the CNG fueling facility so that buses for 5600 West can be serviced there. The original 5600 West Construction request will be covered with other funding.

PI agent cost is about \$15K or about 5% of the ROW acquisition cost. Community relations were also improved.

6. Other Business - *Matt Shipp*

Hugh VanWagenen of WFRC mentioned that there are new AASHTO guidelines for bicycle facilities as well as new guidelines from NACTO.

Kip Billings of WFRC reminded the group that there is an opportunity for TAC members to participate in Road Safety Audits in 2025. Letters of intent are due by January 31, 2025 and should be sent to Kip Billings at WFRC.
