\*\*The Roy project is advanced ahead of the Tooele project in accordance with the Rating and Ranking Criteria general policies, Criterion number 5, adopted in August 2015, which states, "In the event that two or more projects receive the same rating and ranking score, the RRC will then rank them using the regional priorities identified in Criterion 12. Criterion 12 allocates points based on recognized regional priorities under which the Roy project qualifies ahead of the Tooele project.
