



40% of homebuyers look for walkability when choosing where to live




Town Centers bring destinations closer together and provide more transportation choices

FACT


Higher density does not mean a higher tax rate

Lower density does not mean less traffic




As housing density increases, communities often save on infrastructure and other costs

When housing is placed more closely together near a variety of transportation options, congestion often decreases




Housing prices vs. income year to year
