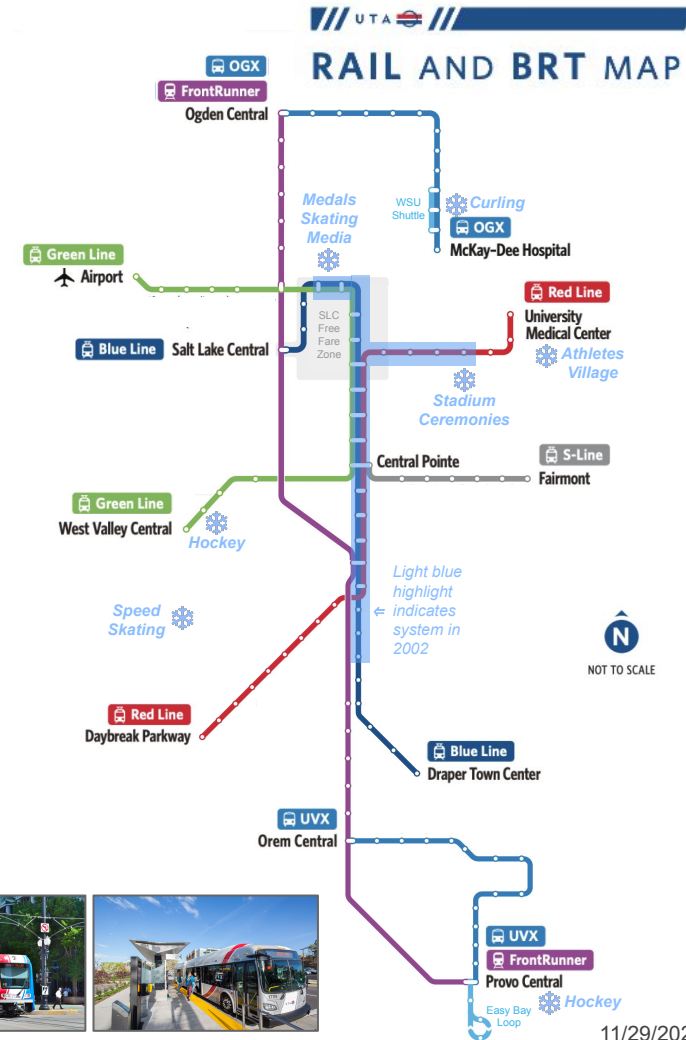
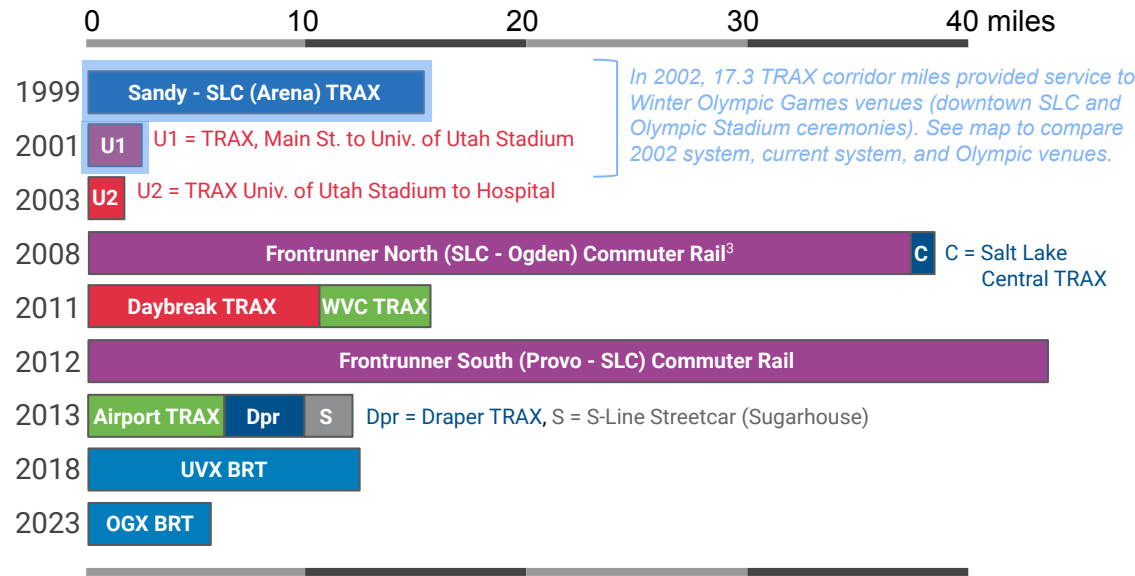


From 0 to 145 Miles in 24 Years

New Corridor Miles of UTA Rail and BRT, by Year (1999-2023)

The graph below shows new corridor miles¹ over the past 24 years of Utah Transit Authority project openings along the Wasatch Front. Taken together, a total of 129 miles of rail transit corridor and 16 miles² of Bus Rapid Transit corridor are currently operating. The colors and labels shown reference the current transit route that originally utilized the constructed project.



¹ Corridor miles are miles of transit infrastructure – as depicted on the schematic map at right – and does not include double tracking or use by concurrent TRAX routes.

² BRT corridor mileage includes the full routes, including 5.3 miles (UGX) and 1.7 miles (OGX) of bus-only lane configurations.

³ Does not include the 6.2 mile Pleasant View segment that is currently not in service.
